

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

September 15, 2022

PLANNING

Planning Commission Meeting – The September 12 Planning Commission meeting was canceled.

General Plan Update (GPU) Phase 2 – Staff was informed that the updated traffic model for SANDAG's 2021 Regional Plan (Series 14) has been completed. The project alternatives for GPU Phase 2 (reviewed by the City Council on August 10) will now be calibrated to the model, and once this calibration is complete, the modeling of future traffic conditions under these alternatives may begin. It is anticipated that the model runs for the GPU Phase 2 project alternatives will be completed in late October.

ENGINEERING

Oceanside Navigation Center (Shelter) – Additional demolition was added to the project scope of work and will be started next week. Sewer lateral work, electrical rough-in, and relocation of electrical panels continued this week.

Annual Slurry Seal/Street Overlay Project - Survey and concrete layout work continued this week.

Beachfront Improvement Feasibility Study Phase II – The study was scheduled for the Parks and Recreation Commission on September 13 for review and formal recommendation to City Council, however, the meeting was canceled. A new meeting date will be finalized shortly and updated information will be posted on the City's study website and emailed to the interested parties list.

Brooks Street ADA Sidewalk Project – The contractor received the Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (*right*) from the manufacturer; they will be installed this week. Asphalt work is scheduled for September 23 and is expected to be completed in three days. After the asphalt work, the final remaining items are striping and installation of various traffic signs.



College Blvd. Widening from Barnard Dr. / Waring Rd. to Old Grove Rd. – Staff met with the Oceanside Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee on September 12 and received feedback on the proposed bikeway design for College Blvd. The design consultant continues to work on the draft design that will be presented at a public outreach meeting, tentatively scheduled to occur in October.

New Fire Station No. 1 – Hazardous material abatement has been completed and removed from the site. SDG&E is scheduled to de-energize the site this week and demolition of the buildings is scheduled to begin the week of September 19. Building demolition is anticipated to be completed in early October.

Jim Wood Park Sign Unveiling - The unveiling ceremony of the new sign for Jim Wood Community Park will take place on Saturday, September 24 at 2:00 p.m. The public is welcome to this event as we honor former Mayor Jim Wood for his long-time service to Oceanside.

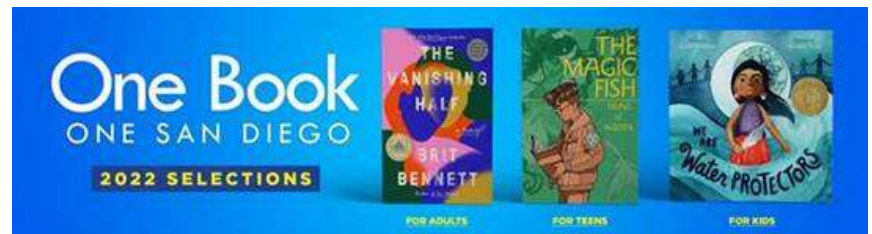

Oceanside Author's Novel Chosen for One Book, One San Diego - Author of choice, Brit Bennett, who wrote *The Vanishing Half*, grew up in Oceanside and began her first job at the age of 16 at the Oceanside Public Library. Her book was the selection



for adults to be read throughout San Diego County in October. Bennett will be appearing in person on Thursday, October 6 at 6:30 p.m. at San Diego State University to discuss her book. The Library will be supporting One Book One San Diego programming by hosting a special book club on Saturday, October 29 at 3:00 p.m. at the Civic Center Library, with appetizers provided by Felix's BBQ with Soul. For a free copy of the book, simply sign up for the book club at oceansidepubliclibrary.org.

In its 16th year, One Book, One San Diego is a community reading program. It is a partnership between KPBS, local libraries, and many other key community partners. The purpose of the program is to bring our community together and encourage residents to join together in the shared experience of reading and discussing the same book. This year, the selections include: adult book, *The Vanishing Half* by Brit Bennett; teen book, *The Magic Fish* by Trung Le Nguyen; and kids' book, *We Are Water Protectors* by Carole Lindstrom and illustrated by Michaela Goade. Both the adult and kids' selections are available in Spanish translation.
