PLANNING

General Plan Update Phase 2 – On October 18, the Planning Division hosted an open house event (*pictured below*) in support of the second phase of the General Plan Update, with specific focus on the Efficient & Compatible Land Use Element, the Integrated Mobility Element, and the Remarkable Community Element. Next week's second open house on October 26 will focus on the Vital and Sustainable Resources Element, the Healthy and Livable Community Element, and the Safe and Resilient Environment Element.



ENGINEERING

New Fire Station 1 – Demolition of the site is complete. Grading operations started this week; grading/excavation is anticipated to be completed by October 26. Temporary power will be installed this week. Rincon Tribal representatives will be present on-site for grading activities.

Pier View Way Bridge and Lifeguard Headquarters – The second project outreach meeting is scheduled for November 10 at 6:30 p.m. in the Civic Center Library Community Rooms. Please visit the <u>project specific webpage</u> for information.

Brooks Street ADA Sidewalk Project – The rapid flashing beacon crosswalk was installed at the site on October 14. With installation of the rapid flashing beacons, the project is now complete. A community celebration is scheduled for October 24 at La Casita (402 Brooks Street).

San Luis Rey River Flood Control Project Mowing The Public Works Department has completed the mowing operations for 2022, which began September 19. Approximately 80 acres were mowed within the Phase 1 and 2 sections of the San Luis Rey River Flood Control Project. Public Works staff will continue maintenance obligations into the 2023.
