#### **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

November 17, 2022

### **PLANNING**

**General Plan Update Phase 2** – In light of further delay in the SANDAG regional traffic modeling process, the Planning Division intends to work directly with SANDAG's traffic consultant, RSG, to conduct traffic modeling for the second phase of the City's General Plan Update (GPU Phase 2). This alternative approach is anticipated to prevent an approximate sixmonth delay in the GPU Phase 2 schedule, and will enable completion of the project in early fall 2023.

Buena Vista Lagoon Joint Powers Committee (JPC) – The next Buena Vista Lagoon JPC meeting is scheduled for November 21 at 3:30 p.m.; it will be a virtual meeting.

### **ENGINEERING**

**Annual Slurry Seal / Street Overlay Project -** Concrete ADA ramp reconstruction in Tri-City North continued this week.

**Pier View Way Bridge and Lifeguard Headquarters –** The second public outreach meeting for the project was held on November 10. The intent of the meeting was to provide a brief project history, project update including staff recommendations, solicit feedback from the public, and discuss next steps and the project schedule. Staff's recommendations included reconstruction of the pier bridge and lifeguard headquarters, with the addition of a new tiered lifeguard support facility on the east side of the Strand. Twelve people attended this public meeting. Those in attendance provided a variety of viewpoints and comments which are currently being analyzed by the project team. The item is tentatively scheduled to be brought before the Oceanside Historic Preservation Advisory Committee on January 17, 2023.


**College Blvd. Widening from Barnard Dr. / Waring Rd. to Old Grove Rd. –** Staff is reviewing the concept design to determine whether feedback received during a recent meeting has been addressed in the drawings.

**Cleveland Storm Drain –** Staff continues to monitor right-of-way permits as utility companies relocate to clear space for the proposed larger storm drain system. California Coastal Commission (CCC) staff has made requests to change the proposed design and submitted additional questions regarding sand placement and maintenance. Staff is in the process of preparing a letter for submittal to CCC staff to address their most recent requests and questions.

### Oceanside Navigation Center (Shelter) – The following work occurred this week:

- Bids analyzed for north-facing window replacements
- Coordinated existing storm drain line with the new sewer lateral work
- Continued building new walls
- Continued electrical rough-in and started relocating electrical panel
- Preparing bids for flooring, tile, steel, signage, and millwork

**New Fire Station 1 –** The contractor is completing foundation excavations for the east-side retaining wall and installing electrical and plumbing utilities.

### **LIBRARY**

Art Restoration - The Library, with support from the Arts Commission, is addressing restoration of the City's current art registry. Repairs are currently under way on the Last Wave of Day sculpture, located at Myers Street and Pier View way. The surfing-themed sculpture by artist Steve Rieman, a community favorite, was originally installed in April 2004, and is constructed of polished stainless steel, weathered steel, and cast concrete. Repairs are expected to be completed by the end of November.
