#### **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

November 23, 2022

### **PLANNING**

**Cannabis Update** – At its January 11, 2023 meeting, the City Council is scheduled to consider a Conditional Use Permit and Waiver of Locational Requirements for Herb Girl, Inc. to operate a cannabis distribution business in an existing building.

**Oceanside Transit Center Redevelopment –** Staff provided the applicant with the first round of project review comments on September 30 and are awaiting a resubmittal with responses to comments. The applicant plans to conduct additional public outreach in the coming months.

**El Corazon OBC Projects –** Staff is reviewing the third submittal for the project and is working with the project applicant to resolve outstanding comments. The proposed project is anticipated to be brought before the El Corazon Standing Committee for review and discussion in early January 2023.

**Buena Vista Lagoon Joint Powers Committee (JPC) –** The Buena Vista Lagoon JPC held its regular meeting on November 21 with committee members Devaney and Jensen absent. Updates were provided on the following items:

- Restoration of Audubon Society's Wetland Preserve
- Buena Vista Lagoon Enhancement Ad-hoc Committee: grant opportunities
- Buena Vista Lagoon Cattail Control Ad-hoc Committee: continued efforts toward cattail removal and future funding

The next meeting will be hosted by the City of Carlsbad and is scheduled for January 16, 2023.

**Planning Commission -** The Planning Commission held its regular meeting on November 21 with all commissioners present. The following item was considered:

 Confirm issuance of the Notice of Exemption; and Approve a Zone Amendment, Local Coastal Plan Amendment, and Municipal Code Amendment for proposed revisions to the City's Inclusionary Housing policies.

The Planning Commission recommended City Council approval (Vote 4-3; Commissioners Rosales, Dodds, Malik – No).

# **ENGINEERING**

**Prince Memorial Park Restroom** - The waterline has been installed and the restroom was delivered the week of November 7 (*right*). Remedial site and ADA concrete work is in the final stages of completion. The project is expected to be fully complete by the end of next week.

**Beachfront Improvements Project, Phase 1 –** The contractor is finalizing punch list items in preparation of project acceptance by the City. Landscaping will be addressed as part of the corrections.

#### Oceanside Navigation Center (Shelter) - The following work occurred this week:

- Awarded north-facing windows replacement contract
- Coordinated existing storm drain line with new sewer lateral work
- Continued building new walls
- Continued electrical rough-in and electrical panel relocation
- Advertised bidding for flooring, tile, steel, signage, and millwork







**New Fire Station No. 1 –** Work continues on the retaining wall foundation as well as installation of building plumbing and electrical. Vertical construction is anticipated to begin in December 2022.

**Personnel Update** - On November 18, Oceanside Fire celebrated the past year's new hires, promotions, retirements, and special awards. Four Firefighter Recruits will start on 11/28, and they will perform EMS only until academy completion. Interviews for a new group of EMTs occur next week.
