COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

PLANNING

Park Impact Fee Study – City Council briefings will soon be scheduled to discuss Park Impact Fee Study results and staff's recommendation for an updated park impact fee.

El Corazon Oceanside Boulevard Commercial Project – Staff continues to review the proposed project and will provide comments on the applicant's third submittal in the coming week.

ENGINEERING

Pier View Way Bridge and Lifeguard Headquarters – City and California Coastal Commission (CCC) staff met last week to discuss the proposed project, during which CCC staff requested additional information regarding the proposed Lifeguard Headquarters. Staff is compiling the requested information.

Crown Heights Americans with Disabilities Act Community Development Block Grant Project - The City has selected Heritage Architecture and Planning of San Diego to perform the Historic Structure Assessment Report and related services for the Crown Heights Community Resource Center building. The City will next prepare a Professional Services Agreement to award a contract and begin the work.

New Fire Station 1 Work continues on the retaining wall foundation. Most utilities have been installed. Next week, the contractor will begin constructing concrete foundations and preparing the building slab. Vertical construction is now set for January 2023.



LIBRARY

Special Library Programs - On Thursday, December 15 from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., the Oceanside Public Library will host "Humans of Oceanside." The Library invites you to break down barriers and break bread with those who bring O'Siders together: a community farmer, mutual aid organizers, a culture connector and artist, roller skaters and silent disco dancers.

On Saturday, December 17 at 10:00 a.m., join the Library for a Sitting "Walking Tour" of Oceanside. Local historian John Daley will "walk" you through Downtown Oceanside and share a personalized view of our City, sharing some of his favorite images from the Oceanside Historical Society's collection to help the audience visualize the Oceanside in which he grew up. Both free programs will take place in the Civic Center Library's Community Rooms.

WATER UTILITIES

Oceanside Landfill Weeks - From December 5-16 the City of Oceanside is offering "Landfill Weeks." If you ran out of Large Item Landfill Pickups at your door, schedule additional pickups during landfill weeks free of charge by calling Waste Management at (760)439-2824. Acceptable items include couches, chairs, computers, televisions, printers, fax machines, cell phones and tablets that are beyond reuse or repair. Household hazardous waste is not accepted.

"Dump Day" Event December 10 at Mance Buchanon Park – Green Oceanside, Neighborhood Services, and Code Enforcement will host a Dump Day event on Saturday, December 10 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Residents can drive-up and drop off materials beyond reuse and repair such as furniture, home goods, mattresses etc. Electronic recycling will also be available. Household hazardous waste (HHW) will not be accepted, however staff will provide information on how to schedule a drop-off at the Waste Management HHW facility. PARKS AND RECREATION

Major Swim Meet Returns to Oceanside - The William A. Wagner Aquatic Center will be the site of the San Diego-Imperial Swimming Organizations Winter Age Group Championship. This event, held December 17-19, will feature nearly 900 swimmers and teams, along with family members, coaches and officials from the Western United States and Northern Mexico. San Diego-Imperial Swimming has worked closely with Oceanside hotels to procure room blocks and provide information on dining and entertainment available in Oceanside. While the meet is open to the public, the facility will be closed to public swimming. Those wishing to swim are invited to visit the Marshall Street Swim Center, located at 1404 Marshall Street, which will be open during regular operating hours.

Temporary Closure at Junior Seau Beach Community Center - The Junior Sear Beach Community Center will be closed temporarily to resurface the gymnasium floor beginning December 18 and will reopen on January 3. The Parks and Recreation Department resurfaces gymnasium flooring every two years in an effort to continue to provide quality facilities.
