#### **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

February 17, 2023

## **PLANNING**

**El Corazon Oceanside Boulevard Commercial Project –** The Economic Development Commission (EDC) was scheduled to consider the proposed project at its Feb. 14 meeting, however the meeting was canceled due to lack of quorum. A special meeting of the El Corazon Standing Committee, comprised of Commissioners from the EDC, is scheduled for February 23 at 2:00 p.m.

**Eddie Jones Warehouse Project -** The applicant is currently preparing an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and addressing remaining project compliance items, including a public outreach report. The Draft EIR will be circulated for a 45-day public review in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act. The proposed project requires consideration by the San Diego County Airport Land Use Commission prior to being considered by the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission is the decision-making body on the proposed development plan, conditional use permits and variance, as well as consideration and certification of the EIR. The decision of the Planning Commission may be appealed to the City Council.

**Planning Commission –** The Planning Commission meeting scheduled for February 13 was canceled.

### **ENGINEERING**

**Slurry Seal/Street Overlay Project -** Asphalt street repair work continues <u>at the following areas</u>: Del Oro (3D), Cameo (3E), Guajome South (2E), North Valley (2A), Canyon Adjacent (1B), and Tri City North (3F). Concrete ADA ramp improvements are scheduled to finish at Tri-City North (3F) and Frazee (4A) this week. Upon completion of those improvements, the contractor will proceed with groups Guajome South (2E), Cassidy (3C), and Canyon Adjacent (1B).

New Fire Station No. 1 – Work on foundations and slabs continued this week.

**Oceanside Navigation Center –** The following work occurred this week:

- Completed installing fire sprinkler system throughout the building
- Prepared site to bore the new sewer main
- Started drywall repairs
- Coordinated electrical upgrades with SDGE
- Completed new HVAC & Electrical design
- Started exterior paint
- Started fabricating handrails
- Began coring walkway for new handrails



**Coast Highway Corridor Design** – A kick-off meeting for the proposed project occurred this week. The project design process is anticipated to take 18 months to complete and includes public outreach opportunities.

## **FIRE**

**New Ambulance Service** – The third EMT Ambulance went in service on February 5 after the completion of EMT Academy 10 (additional 11 full and part-time EMTs).

**Enhanced Harbor Safety Services Plan** – Th planned transition was finalized with the Fire Department's Marine Safety Unit put in service on February 5, 2023. This program provides:

- 24-hour Lifeguard response
- Advanced Life Support (Paramedic) / Basic Life Support (EMT) response unit in the Oceanside Small Craft Harbor District
- Improved Boat Operations Boat operator, rescue swimmer, deckhand

**Fire Academy 20** – The new Academy started February 13, 2023, with 15 new Firefighter Recruits, nine of which are prior OFD EMTs. Graduation will be March 31.

## WATER UTILITIES

#### Food Scraps to Energy Workshop February 22

A workshop will be held from 5:00-6:00 p.m. at the San Luis Rey Water Reclamation Facility to inform the community about the project and its goal to create a local, sustainable, and renewable energy source from food scraps and food soiled paper collected from businesses and multifamily homes. The first workshop will be hosted in advance of the CEQA Notice posting on February 24. An informational mailing about the project and workshop will be mailed to residents within a 1,500 ft. radius of the project and posted electronically through the City's various media platforms and through the WaterSmart portal. A follow-up workshop will also be held in March during the CEQA public comment period (Date to be determined). <u>More information</u>



**Direct Install Program for Toilets and Irrigation Controllers** – A new program funded by state grants to the San Diego County Water Authority and its member agencies will install free, premium, high-efficiency toilets and smart irrigation controllers for Oceanside residents who qualify, based on household income. These new devices can help residential customers lower their water use, which can have a positive impact on their monthly water bill. **Kitchen Food Scraps Pail Delivery -** Free kitchen food scraps pails for multi-family tenants were delivered to three apartment complexes. Through a recently awarded grant, the City was able to purchase food scraps pails for its organic recycling program. To date, the City has distributed over 800 pails to local complexes.
