COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

March 9, 2023

PLANNING

El Corazon Oceanside Boulevard Commercial Projects – The proposed project is scheduled for consideration by the Planning Commission at its April 10 meeting.

Eddie Jones Warehouse Project – City staff met with the applicant to discuss the proposed project and community concerns.

ENGINEERING

Annual Slurry Seal/Street Overlay Project - Asphalt street repair work resumed this week at 3F Tri-City North with asphalt digouts and overlay of streets. Concrete ADA ramp improvements continue at 4B Ocean Ranch and will be followed by improvements at 1B Canyon Adjacent in the next two weeks. Updated project maps with changed scopes of the asphalt work are attached.

Coast Highway Corridor Design - The project consultant is currently working on data collection which includes obtaining field topographic survey and boundary mapping along Coast Highway.

Ron Ortega Dog Park Facility – The internal review panel has identified the recommended consultant for project design. Negotiations are underway should be finalized by the end of week. Staff anticipates requesting City Council consideration to award the design contract at its March 22 meeting.

Oceanside Police Department Headquarter Relocation - A public information meeting is scheduled for March 15 at the William. A. Wagner Aquatic Center from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.

New Fire Station 1 - Framing of the Apparatus Bay No. 1 building and off-site sewer work is scheduled to begin next week. Freeman Street is now operating under a one-way traffic route between Sportfisher and Civic Center.


Crown Heights Americans with Disabilities Act Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Project - The City's internal review panel has completed its rating of consultant proposals for the project's Architectural and Engineering Design and Environmental Services (Phase 2). Phase 1 of the project is progressing and is expected to be completed in May 2023. Staff anticipates requesting City Council consideration to award the Phase 2 contract at its May 3 meeting.

PUBLIC WORKS

Oceanside Boulevard Roadway Repairs – This week, Public Works staff made roadway repairs to the #2 eastbound lane on Oceanside Boulevard from Hoover Street to Foussat Road.



Pier Utility Replacement Project - The Pier Utility Replacement Project continues. Connection work for the temporary sewer, water and pier lighting services have been completed. Demolition of existing water, and sewer pipelines and lighting electrical conduits are underway from Bent 0 to Bent 18. Replacement of water and sewer lines have started within those Bents as well. Scaffolding work at Bent 18 to 35 will be completed next week which will allow westward progression of demolition and construction.



Successful Tree Planting Celebration – The Public Works Department held an Arbor Day Tree Planting event on Saturday, March 4. Over 50 residents joined us to plant 33 willow trees at Buchanon Park. Thank you to the Mayor and Councilmembers who joined in to help with the Arbor Day Proclamation and tree-planting demonstration. Planting these community trees helps clean the air, reduce pollutants, shelter biodiversity, provide shade, beauty, and improve our health. It also adds to Oceanside's "green infrastructure" that appreciates in value over time.

























GROUP 3D - DEL ORO


