COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

March 17, 2023

PLANNING

General Plan Update (GPU) Phase 2 - Staff is reviewing a draft of the Smart and Sustainable Corridors Specific Plan (SSCSP), which will establish new land use policies and zoning standards for segments of Mission Avenue, Oceanside Boulevard, and Vista Way. The SSCSP is expected to be available for public review in May. Once the public review draft is completed, the City will host an in-person open house on the SSCSP and subsequently provide for remote review and comment on the draft document via an online platform.

Planning Commission - The Planning Commission held its regular meeting on March 13 with all 7 commissioners present. The following item was considered:

 Development Plan, Regular Coastal Permit, and Request for Density Bonus to allow the demolition of two single-family homes and one triplex and the construction of a three-story apartment complex consisting of 16 market-rate units and one very low-income affordable unit at 1931-1933 South Tremont Street. The applicant is JLH FXS TREMONT, LLC. The Planning Commission recommended City Council approval (Vote: 6 yes - Commissioner Malik no).

The Planning Commission also inquired about the status of Brother Benno's efforts to address concerns raised by surrounding industrial park businesses. The City Planner apprised the Commission of staff's on-going discussions with Brother Benno's management aimed at resolving these concerns.

ENGINEERING

Buccaneer Park Project - Staff has determined that the scope of work should be revised to include modifications to the existing café building. The proposed revisions include removal of the existing public restrooms and converting the old restroom area into usable space for the café. Staff will meet to review the revised scope of work and additional proposed cost for design and re-construction of the Café.

Ron Ortega Dog Park Facility - Staff is scheduled to request City Council approval to award a design contract to KTU&A at its March 22 meeting.

College Blvd. Widening from Barnard Dr./Waring Rd. to Old Grove Rd. - Staff and the project's consultant are preparing to present a bike track design to the Bicycle Advocacy Group on March 20. Utility coordination continues with AT&T, Cox, and SDG&E. NCTD has completed its review of the bus stop design.
