COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

June 15, 2023

PLANNING

Planning Commission – The Planning Commission's June 12 meeting was cancelled. A discussion of possible modifications/updates to Brother Benno's conditions of approval for their existing Conditional Use Permit is tentatively scheduled for the next Planning Commission meeting on June 26 at 6:00 p.m.

ENGINEERING

Oceanside Navigation Center – City staff met with the contractor and operators this week for updates and to tour the work progress. Work this week included:

- Plumbing contractor continued rough plumbing. Inspection of full plumbing system will be completed this week
- Installation of gas line started and connection to water main line was completed
- Concrete contractor started forming the central ramp on the courtyard
- Continued performing stucco repairs in preparation for exterior paint
- Fire alarm installation commenced this week



Pier View Way Bridge & Lifeguard Headquarters – Staff submitted formal project correspondence to the California Coastal Commission (CCC) in September 2022 requesting general support of the project. In April 2023, staff received a response letter from the CCC that generally supports the project. Based on this support, the project feasibility study is being finalized and will be brought before the Oceanside Historic Preservation Advisory Commission on July 18for review and formal recommendation to City Council in August 2023.


Road Slurry Seal & Overlay Project - Road work continues as follows (Work Area Map):

- Group 3A: Oceanside Blvd. at Coast Highway paving was re-scheduled due to weather
- Group 4B: Ocean Ranch overlay paving (Old Grove and Avenida del Oro) happening at night this week
- Group 1C: Sea Mesa ADA ramp construction will continue for the next three weeks

Crown Heights Community Resource Center ADA CDBG Project – A kickoff meeting was held at the Crown Heights Resource Center with City stakeholders and the consultant. Valuable input was obtained from everyone present. The first step of the project is collecting data to use in the design; data collection will commence in the coming week.

CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE

Reducing Homelessness – The recent release of data relating to homelessness in the region through the Point-in-Time Count indicated an 8.8 percent reduction in Oceanside. While this one-night snapshot is by no accounts a complete depiction, it's a data point that helps guide services and funding in San Diego County. Staff across nearly every city department works on these issues from multiple angles as is evidenced by this downward trend. POLICE

FIRE

EMT Recruitment Efforts - The Fire Department is interviewing EMTs for the next round of hiring. The potential pool of candidates has grown from 24 to well over 100 as a result of increased recruitment efforts and the recently approved Measure X EMT incentive plan.

Lithium Battery Fire Training - The Fire Department recently underwent training from County Hazardous Materials personnel about lithium batteries used in e-bikes and scooters. There are significant increases in fires related to these battery-powered devices across the country and in Oceanside.

WATER UTILITIES

Cleanup Helps Keep Oceanside Beautiful – On June 10, Green Oceanside hosted a Dump Day event in collaboration with Housing & Neighborhood Services and Code Enforcement at the Crown Heights Community Resource Center and Balderrama Park. Community volunteers also participated in helping cleanup neighborhoods and helping load dumpsters. Over 13 large roll-off dumpsters were filled.

Hands-on Learning for Oceanside Students – Fourth and fifth graders from Mission Elementary enjoyed a visit from The Splash Science Lab in May where they learned about water and the environment through interactive stations such as chemistry experiments and watershed models. The mobile lab is run by the San Diego County Office of Education and these visits were provided by the Water Utilities Department in collaboration with the San Diego County Water Authority.
