

# COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

February 17, 2022

## PLANNING

The January 24, 2022, Planning Commission meeting was canceled due to lack of quorum.

## ENGINEERING

**Annual Slurry Seal Project** – The contractor completed punch list work items last week. Remaining work includes crosswalk markings and additional roadway markings in District 4, scheduled to occur within the next two weeks.

**Beachfront Improvements Project** – Construction of the future Police substation, maintenance building, public restrooms, and site work continues this week. The interior plumbing rough-in is complete at the future Police substation. Exterior wrap and plaster will be installed soon. Structural steel roof framing, corrugated metal roofing, and doors/hardware are under construction at the public restroom. Plumbing fixtures and toilet accessories will be installed soon. Interior wall framing, plumbing and electrical rough-ins, drywall, and HVAC are under construction at the maintenance building. Remaining plaza pavers will be installed soon.

**Brooks Street Sidewalk/ADA Project** – The mandatory pre-bid meeting was conducted on February 9, 2022 with potential bidders.

**Neptune Stairway Repair** – The contractor continues electrical work to restore lights. Pending any weather delays affecting lighting installation, the stairs are anticipated to be open to the public in approximately two weeks.

**Redistricting Process Update** - The next step in Oceanside's redistricting process has begun. 3 draft maps were selected to move forward with, and they are now posted on the [redistricting webpage](#) for feedback. The last two redistricting Public Hearings will occur on February 23 and March 9 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers.
