

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

PLANNING

General Plan Update Phase 2 – On April 19, the Planning Division hosted a community Open House on the draft Smart & Sustainable Corridors Plan, a key component of the City's General Plan Update. A summary of input received at the Open House will be posted to the project webpage onwardoceanside.com by May 2.

Park Impact Fee Study - On April 28, staff will hold a stakeholder meeting with the development community to discuss and gather input on the proposed Park Impact Fee methodology.

ENGINEERING

Street Overlay Project – The contractor continued working on the demolition and replacement of all concrete flatwork, pedestrian ramps, and existing curb for the S. The Strand Improvement project being funded by Measure X.

Buccaneer Park Project – The consultant is working on presentation materials for the May 3 community meeting to be held in the City Council Chambers from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m.

Brooks Street ADA Project –The construction contract will be presented for City Council consideration on May 4. Staff is working with the Boys & Girls Club to set a date for the community outreach event, which will inform the public about the proposed project. Additionally, staff will be presenting the proposed project at the April 25 virtual meeting “Safe Routes to Healthy Places,” hosted by the Vista Community Clinic.

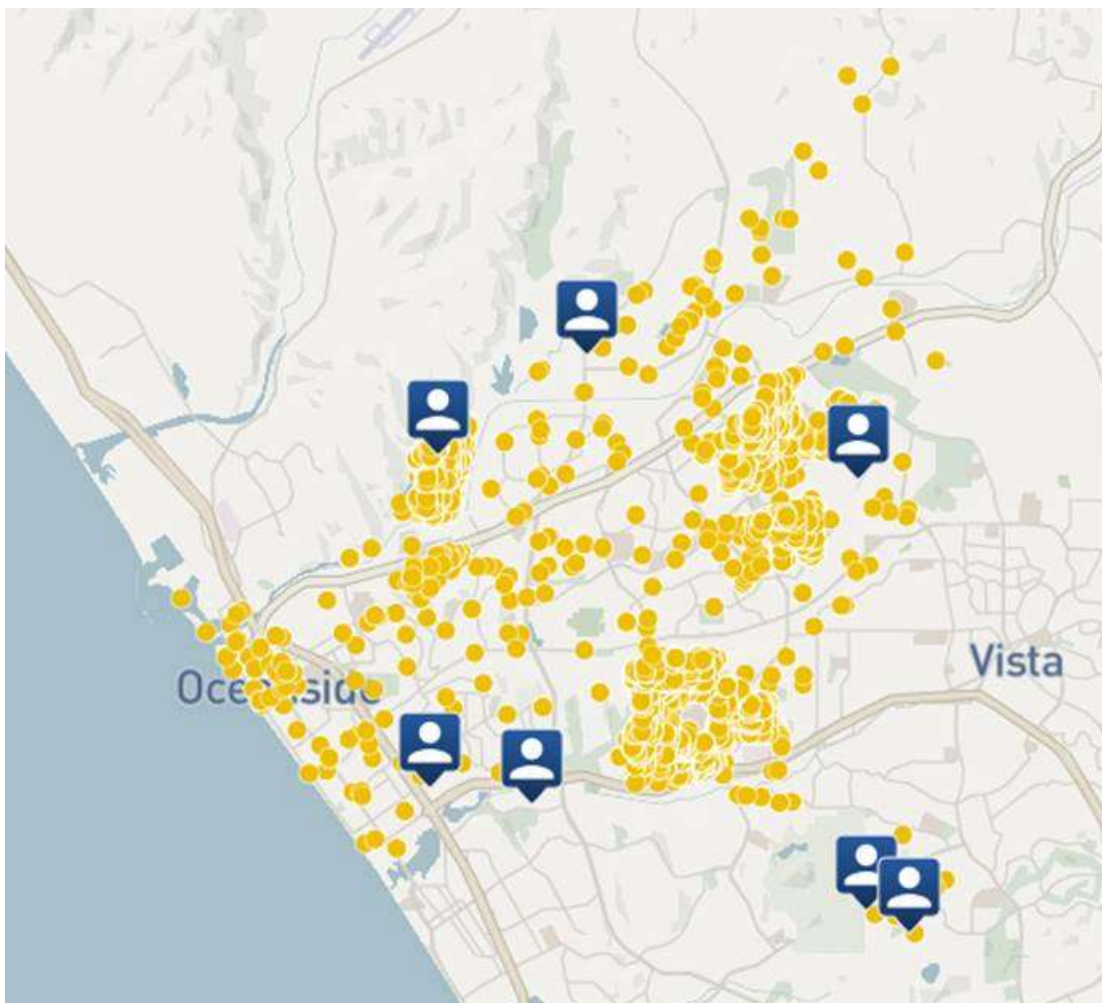
Cleveland Storm Drain Project - Engineering and Water Utilities staff met with the design consultant on April 20 to address questions and concerns regarding the relocation design for the Camp Pendleton force main. The goal was to make any necessary revisions to the design so the project goes out to bid in May.

WATER UTILITIES

Earth Day of Service and Celebration – The Green Oceanside team will host an Earth Day of Service and Celebration on Saturday, April 23 at Buccaneer Park from 9:00 a.m. -1:00 p.m. The event will be filled with arts, crafts, and activities centered around sustainability and taking action to protect our planet. Guests will learn about local sustainability efforts, enjoy music, and can receive a free “Stay Classy O’side” t-shirt and fanny pack. Attendees will be encouraged to join in the cleanup effort to protect our local creek and waterways. Oceanside has partnered with “I Love a Clean San Diego” to offer five cleanup sites throughout the City that volunteers may participate at. WaterSmart Meter Project –The WaterSmart Meter Project utilizing advanced meter infrastructure (AMI) is part of the City’s continued efforts to enhance customer service, improve water efficiency, and replace aging infrastructure. The WaterSmart Meter Project will transition the City of Oceanside from monthly in-person meter readings to meters that provide remote water use updates on an hourly basis. Customers with a WaterSmart meter have 24/7 access to their near real time-data, allowing them to view their water usage more closely, identify the possibility of leaks, reduce overall water waste, and ultimately have greater bill transparency. To date, the City has installed 7,012 WaterSmart meters which have been transmitting hourly reads to customers and billing information to the City since installation.

Since January 1, 2022, 759 customers have been alerted to a potential leak through the WaterSmart customer portal. The WaterSmart customer portal will send customers a leak alert if their meter has registered at least 2.5 gallons of water being used per hour for 72 hours straight. This provides a significant benefit, as the customer is now able to quickly act on an unknown leak and avoid an unforeseen bill increase. The City has received several positive messages from customers who have been able to address leaks within their homes. The yellow dots on the map below represent meters that have been upgraded to the WaterSmart AMI meters.
