## ENGINEERING

**Buccaneer Park (Project Study Report)** – The first public outreach meeting will be a “pop-up” held on July 10 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Buccaneer Park. [Flyer](#)

## WATER UTILITIES

**Monica Circle Sewer Replacement** - Bid opening for the Monica Circle Sewer Replacement project was held on June 24, 2021. Staff has observed defects in the pipeline with CCTV video which prioritized it for replacement. Five (5) bids were received with the apparent low bid coming in below the budget estimate for the project. Staff is reviewing bid documents and anticipates recommending an award of the contract at a City Council meeting in August. Construction is expected to begin in September 2021 and be complete by December 2021.

**Sewer Point Repair Program** - A contract was awarded to DB Pipeline Inc. for the Sewer Point Repair Package No. 5, which includes repairs of existing gravity sewer mains at five (5) locations throughout the City. Notice to Proceed was issued on June 25, 2021 to begin construction. Construction is expected to be complete by September 2021. A contract was awarded to GDM Inc. for the Sewer Point Repair Package No. 6, which includes repairs of existing gravity sewer mains at five (5) locations throughout the City. Notice to Proceed was issued on June 23, 2021 to begin construction. Construction is expected to be complete by September 2021
