COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

March 7, 2024

PLANNING

General Plan Update (GPU) Phase 2 – The Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the project is currently being reviewed by City staff. The project team seeks to release the DEIR for public review in early April. All project components will be appended to the DEIR (i.e. six new/updated General Plan elements, Smart and Sustainable Corridors Plan, updated Climate Action Plan). City Council briefings regarding the General Plan Update Program are in the process of being scheduled by staff.

Planning Commission – The March 11 Planning Commission meeting is cancelled. The next regularly scheduled meeting is Monday, March 25 at 6:00 p.m.

ENGINEERING

Buena Vista Audubon Society Crosswalk Feasibility Study (CIP23-00019) – Staff is in the data collection phase of this study. Staff performed field work this week reviewing sight distances.

City Wide Fiber Optic Projects –The high-speed fiber construction projects are progressing as follows:

SiFi Networks

- A Stop Work Order was issued on February 28. Since then, staff and SiFi representatives have had several discussions on the City's expectations regarding the quality of construction and storm water management. The order is anticipated to be lifted this week.
- Work to continue in the Marlado Highlands, Airport, and North Valley area neighborhoods.

Ubiquity

- This week work continued in the Mira Costa area neighborhood.

Cleveland Storm Drain – Staff is continuing work to expedite the construction of the project to the greatest extent feasible. An amendment to the design consultants' contract to revise the plans and specifications for project bidding purposes is scheduled for the March 27 City Council meeting agenda. Staff is meeting this week to consider a temporary storm drain connection option to facilitate a design change and preparation of the bid documents.

College Blvd. Widening (Barnard Dr./Waring Rd. to Old Grove Rd.) – Staff is completing review of comments received on the proposed storm water improvements, which include changes to the existing storm drain system. Staff met with the design consultant to continue review of the Public Outreach Plan and considered options for additional ways to maintain open communication with nearby residents and businesses. The project design schedule is being updated to accommodate recent design changes. A traffic control plan is under design for use during the upcoming geotechnical investigations along College Blvd.

Pier View Bridge & Lifeguard Headquarters and Beachfront Phase II Projects – The consultant team continues to work on the two scoped preliminary design concept options (15% level) and necessary CEQA-related historical analysis and documentation component for the PEIR.

Road Slurry Seal & Overlay Project – (Work Area Map):

- Project on hold due to unfavorable weather.
- Paving work at Peacock Hills (Groups 4D, 4E, 4F) will resume on March 11.
- Utility adjustments and roadway markings will follow upon street pavement completion in Peacock Hills.

WATER UTILITIES

\$451,008 CalRecycle SB 1383 Local Assistance Grant Awarded - The City received award notification from CalRecycle regarding the next cycle of CalRecycle's SB 1383 Local Assistance Grant Program. The City is being awarded \$451,008 which is more than CalRecycle's original \$298,679 estimate. These funds will be used by the Water Utilities Department, in conjunction with Library, Neighborhood Services, and Parks and Recreation for edible food recovery education and outreach to businesses, and to purchase supporting equipment and supplies to increase the recovery of edible food. Items to be purchased include refrigerators, a van, food warmers, milk coolers, shelving, and a food dehydrator. This will result in the recovery of additional edible food for consumption by Oceanside residents who are food insecure.
