

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

March 14, 2024

PLANNING

General Plan Update Phase 2 – Staff is conducting individual briefings with Councilmembers the week of March 18 on the updated General Plan elements, the Smart and Sustainable Corridors Specific Plan, and the updated Climate Action Plan.

Planning Commission – The next regular Planning Commission meeting is scheduled for Monday, March 25 at 6:00 p.m.

Buena Vista Lagoon Joint Powers Committee (BVL JPC) – The next regular meeting is scheduled for Monday, March 18 at 3:30 p.m. in the Oceanside Council Chambers.

Downtown Advisory Committee (DAC) – A Special DAC Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, March 27 at 9 a.m.

ENGINEERING

Road Slurry Seal and Overlay Project – ([Work Area Map](#)):

- Paving work at Peacock Hills (Groups 4D, 4E, 4F) resumed on Monday, March 11 only to be halted the next morning due to weather conditions. Project resuming this week, weather permitting.
- Interim repair of the travel lanes on Vista Way between Stewart Street and Coast Hwy. intersection are being reviewed as another Change Order to the project. The schedule of repair work is targeted for mid/late April 2024.

Oceanside Police Department Headquarter (HQ) Relocation – Structural analysis is beginning on a selected alternative site option. Per recent Council discussion, staff is discussing the option of placing the new HQ in the Oceanside Boulevard Commercial area. Staff continues to explore the feasibility of locating a new police firearms training facility in the former Hobie Cat manufacturing facility. Should the project proceed, a Council item would be forthcoming to approve a Professional Services Agreement for preliminary design documents to help scope out and prepare a construction budget.

New Fire Station 1 – Work continues with exterior/interior work. Fiber optic connectivity is underway between City Hall and the new station. Work to paint the building white is complete. Staff provided a tour with Department of Defense representative this week. SDG&E is still working on revised calculations to determine whether equipment they have on-hand will be suitable for the station rather than waiting several months for the originally designed equipment to be manufactured and sent to the site.

Library Courtyard Improvements – The contractor has completed approximately 95 percent of the demolition work, and is now in the process of installing new drainage.

Cleveland Storm Drain – City and Coastal Commission staff met this week to address additional questions and concerns.

City Wide Fiber Optic Projects – The high-speed fiber construction projects are progressing as follows:

- March 18: Work will occur at Garrison/Oceanside Blvd. (Night work)
- March 19: Work will occur at Mission/Airport & San Luis Rey (Night work)
- March 18 – 22: Work will continue to Barnwell St.; Oceanside Blvd./Muirfield Dr./Shadowtree Dr.; Mesa Dr./Oceanside Blvd.; Crouch St/Edgehill Ln.

Ubiquity

- This week, work continued in the MiraCosta area neighborhood.
- March 11 - 15: Shenandoah Dr; Pauline Way
- March 18 -22: Bedford Ave.; Pauline Way
- March 25 -29: Wooster Dr.; Pauline Way

Buena Vista Audubon Society Crosswalk Feasibility Study (CIP23-00019) – Staff continues the data collection phase of this study. Vehicle, pedestrian, and bicycle counts are in the process of being collected.

PUBLIC WORKS

Oceanside Boulevard Roadway Repairs - On March 7, Public Works staff made roadway repairs to the #1 and #2 eastbound lanes on Oceanside Boulevard from El Camino Real to Rancho Del Oro. On March 12, staff completed roadway repairs to the #1 eastbound lane on Oceanside Boulevard from El Camino Real to Rancho Del Oro. Over the next few months staff will continue to make large scale roadway repairs on the City’s arterial streets and smaller repairs to collector and local streets in attempt to recover from the recent rain events.
