#### **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

March 21, 2024

### **PLANNING**

**General Plan Update (GPU) Phase 2** – On Monday, March 25 at 6 p.m., the Planning Division will provide an update on the proposed project during the monthly Safe Routes to Healthy Places meeting, hosted by Vista Community Clinic.

**Modera Mixed-use Project (Motel 6 Site – 815 N. Coast Hwy)** – A Special Downtown Advisory Committee (DAC) meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, March 27 at 9 a.m. The DAC will receive a presentation from the Planning Division regarding the proposed project.

**Planning Commission** – The next regular Planning Commission meeting is scheduled for Monday, March 25 at 6:00 p.m. The agenda will include the following items:

- Melrose Senior Apartments Project
- Local Coastal Plan Amendment and Municipal Code Amendment to introduce an ordinance amending Chapter 24.

### **ENGINEERING**

Road Slurry Seal & Overlay Project – (Work Area Map):

- Paving work in Peacock Hills (Groups 4D, 4E, 4F) continues and is expected to be completed for Groups 4DEF by Friday, March 22, with the final move to Group 4C Blueridge next week.
- Interim repair of the travel lanes on Vista Way, between Stewart Street and Coast Hwy intersection, is being reviewed for inclusion as another Change Order to the project. The schedule for repair work is targeted for mid/late April 2024.



**Buena Vista Audubon Society Crosswalk Feasibility Study** - Staff continues the data collection phase of this study, including the review of accident data for the area. We are awaiting recent traffic count data.

**Coast Highway Corridor Design** – The consultant is actively working on the design, and a 60 percent submittal is expected by in mid-April. Staff continues to engage with surrounding businesses to address questions and concerns. For more project information, please visit: <u>https://www.coast-hwy.org/</u>

**Crown Heights Resource Center ADA CDBG Project** – The consultant is making progress with a 60 percent submittal expected by the end of the month. Additionally, staff is exploring potential nearby locations to place temporary modular building units to continue hosting the programs run at the Center during the construction.

**Full Capture Device Installation** – <u>Work Area Map</u>: The third year of storm drain trash capture devices installation is set to commence on Monday, March 25. The contractor will install 51 devices across various locations throughout the City, with a target completion date of April 9. These devices are required to comply with state laws.

**Pier View Bridge & Lifeguard Headquarters and Beachfront Phase II Projects** -The consultant team is working on the two scoped preliminary design concept options (15 percent level). Two draft conceptions options were submitted to staff for review and comment. Additionally, the consultant team continues to work on the necessary CEQArelated historical analysis and documentation component for the PEIR. The Coastal Development Permit application requesting a waiver for the required test borings is currently under review by the California Coastal Commission.

**City Wide Fiber Optic Projects** – The high-speed fiber installation projects are progressing as follows:

- Work continues in the Marlado Highlands, Airport, and Loma Alta area neighborhoods this week.
- The general contractor is finalizing two open permits and will be requesting a final inspection in the coming weeks.
- Next week, work will occur on San Luis Rey Rd; Edgehill Dr.; Meadowview/Crystal Wood Dr.; Oceanside Blvd.; Morning View Dr./Spindlewood Ct; Southwood/Ashwood Ct.; Shadow Tree Dr./New Branch Ct.; Crestwood Dr./Towkish Dr.; Redwing Dr./Morning View Dr.; Redwing Dr.; Deerfield/Rimhurst/Morning View Dr.

**Strawberry Place and El Camino Real Storm Drain Repair Project** – This proposed project combines two storm drain repair projects into one. A failed corrugated metal pipe in El Camino Real will be repaired and slip lined to extend the life span of the pipeline. The Strawberry Place project also includes a slip lining to extend the life of a corrugated metal storm drain pipeline. The pre-construction meeting was conducted and construction is expected to commence very soon.

## WATER UTILITIES

Marine Debris Reduction Ordinance Educational Workshops for Oceanside Businesses - Last August, the City Council adopted the Marine Debris Reduction Ordinance (MDRO). The new Ordinance specifically addresses polystyrene foam and single-use plastic bags. All retail establishments and food service providers in Oceanside will be required to find sustainable alternatives to these products. Additionally, all businesses will be required to post educational materials about the MDRO requirements for at least one year after each of the prohibitions take effect.

The City is partnering with the Oceanside Chamber of Commerce and MainStreet Oceanside on a series of educational workshops for Oceanside businesses related to MDRO. These workshops are free to attend, but it is requested that businesses register in advance.
