PLANNING

The November 22, 2021 Planning Commission meeting has been cancelled.

ENGINEERING

Street Overlay Project - The contractor finished with dig outs, pavement repairs and placing the overlay pavement in all Districts. Currently the contractor continues to address some new punch list items.

Annual Slurry Seal Project - Slurry Seal work was completed on November 12, 2021 in all Districts. Punch list work in all Districts should be completed by the end of the month. Final roadway marking will be completed on November 19, 2021. Street sweeping will continue until December 8, 2021.

Beachfront Improvement Feasibility Study Phase II – All "discovery phase" public outreach, identified commission and committee, and focused community meetings have taken place, except for the Cultural District Steering Committee meeting.
