Planning

Public Workshop -On March 15, the City will host a public workshop on the Draft Climate Action Plan (CAP) and draft goals and policies of the Energy and Climate Action Element (ECAP). The workshop will be held in the City Council Chambers from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. The first hour will be devoted to an open house featuring staffed stations with infographics depicting draft GHG emissions reduction measures, draft ECAP goals and policies, and opportunities for stakeholders to reduce their individual carbon footprint. The second hour will involve brief presentations and a whole-group question-and-answer session. Input received at the workshop will guide further refinement of both the CAP and ECAP. Draft materials will be available on the project webpage by March 5.

Tri City Medical Center - Permits have been issued for Tri City Medical Center's surface parking lot and contractor mobilization began last week. Construction of this parking lot will allow a portion of the current parking lot to be used for a parking structure. In late December, Tri City Medical Center submitted applications for a Development Plan and Conditional Use Permit for the parking structure; staff expects those permits to go to hearing in late Spring/early Summer.
