

CITY COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

March 9, 2017

Planning

No update; the March 13 Planning Commission meeting is cancelled.

Harbor

Dredging Update - The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has solicited and received proposals to provide the Oceanside Harbor maintenance dredging; the deadline for contractor submittals was February 22, 2017 and they are being evaluated. It is anticipated that the dredging contract will be awarded in the next week or so.

Once the contract is awarded, a contractor usually receives a Notice to Proceed within about three weeks. The contractor will likely take about one week to mobilize their equipment and about two weeks to perform the actual dredging. The contractor would then have approximately one week to demobilize their equipment. It is the intent of the Corps to complete the dredging project by Memorial Day Weekend.

Public Works

Linear Park Seating Areas – Work has begun to reconstruct the larger seating areas along Linear Park which runs on the west side of Pacific Street between Sportfisher Drive and Wisconsin Street. The project was initiated at the request of OPD to remove the visual barrier of the concrete stem walls while patrolling the area. The walls are also a prime target for graffiti, create drainage problems and have become a maintenance burden. The work will be performed



in one seating area at a time and involves removing the concrete stem walls, leveling the soil in the adjacent planters to match the elevation of the sidewalk and removing/replacing plant material which is consistent with the existing design. In addition, all benches will be replaced. The work will not significantly change the overall feel of the area but should aid OPD with their patrolling efforts as well as ease the maintenance issues.

Pier View Way Bridge Concrete Patching Project – Work is almost complete on the northeast quadrant of the structure and the contractor should start moving shoring and scaffolding to the southeast quadrant next week.

RDO Street Light Pole Removals – Work started last week to remove 80 additional deteriorated street light poles in the RDO neighborhoods. Approximately 50 poles have been removed to date and should be completed by next week.

Mesa Drive Paving – City street maintenance staff paved 0.5 mile of one lane of eastbound Mesa Drive from RDO to Ivey Ranch Road on March 8 - 9.

Water Utilities

Downtown Water/Sewer Replacement Project - The Contractor completed replacement of the sewer along Freeman Alley from Neptune to Civic Center last Friday. High lines have been put in place to prepare for the three shutdowns throughout the north east portion of downtown. Three major shutdowns will occur on from 3/7-3/9. Mailers have been sent out to all businesses and residences, and outreach has occurred with impacted businesses. City Hall has a high line in place so it will not be impacted by the shut downs.

Loma Alta Emergency Sewer Relocation Project - The sewer line has been finished and manholes will be coated this week. The curb and gutter on Rancho Del Oro was finished last week and the final stamped concrete will be getting installed this week, then final asphalt and paving next week. K-rail will be removed along Rancho Del Oro by the end of the week (3/1). Temporary taps will be placed for the striping that will occur the following week.

Curb Up – Bulky Item Services and Illegal Dumping Abatement: The City’s new Curb Up services are now in effect. This month the City will be sending direct mailers to inform the community of the new service requirements. The direct mailers will go to landlords of multifamily properties as well as all addresses that have previously participated in curbside bulky item collection weeks. Starting May 1st enforcement letters and education flyers will be sent to properties with bulky item complaints.
