Planning

PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS

AVOCADO HIGHLANDS – Consideration of a TENTATIVE PARCEL MAP (P15-00005), CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP15-00015), and DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D15-00016) requesting to subdivide a 3.108-acre parcel into four single-family residential lots with a designated remainder lot. The project site is located on the east side of Avocado Road between View Street and Ivy Road. – *At the applicant's request, the Commission continued this item to the April 24, 2017 Planning Commission meeting; vote 7-0.*

T-MOBILE @ 1722 South Coast Highway – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP16-00016) and REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC16-00015) for the continued operation of a wireless communications facility. The proposed project includes the continued operation of six wireless antennas and the ability to install an additional six antennas on the roof of an existing commercial building. The subject site is located at 1722 South Coast Highway. -- *The Commission approved the project and adopted the PC resolution; vote 7-0. The appeal period ends April 17, 2017.*

Public Works

Parking Sensor Pilot Project – Staff is working with a vendor who will be installing 5 inground parking sensors on Pacific Street later this week. The sensors will work in conjunction with a nearby mounted camera to determine parking space occupancy and turnover rates. The pilot will provide data that can be used going forward for possible future parking guidance applications, occupancy availability and timed limit enforcement purposes.

RDO Street Light Pole Removals – Work has been substantially completed to remove 80 additional deteriorated street light poles in the RDO neighborhoods. The contractor still needs to do some modifications to the remaining light pole foundations to finish the project.

Parking Lot #10 Paving – City street maintenance staff will be paving this parking lot on March 28 - 30.
