### **Morro Hills No. 1 and No. 2 Reservoir Repairs**

Morro Hills No. 2 Reservoir has been taken out of service. Removal of the tank from service went very smoothly. No disruptions to service were reported. RSH, the contractor, made entry into the tank. Scaffolding and lifts were erected inside the tank in order to perform structural repairs as well as prepare the interior surface of the tank for relining. Morro Hills No. 2 Reservoir is planned to be out of service for the next 8-12 weeks. Residents might notice additional traffic along the required delivery route which includes North River Road, Sleeping Indian, and Wilshire as construction materials and supplies are transported to the reservoir site.

**Arts Commission Update** - Cultural Planning Group was selected by the Arts Commission as the consultant group to create a City Master Plan for the Arts. This item will go before the City Council May 17 for approval with project commencing early June. The project is expected to take one year. The Arts Commission applied for the California Arts Council Cultural Districts pilot program with the Library as the lead organization and Oceanside Museum of Art and MainStreet Oceanside as partners. 30 cities will receive site visits and 10 will be selected for the program. The application process involved mapping cultural resources in the downtown area.
