City Manager's Office

San Luis Rey Substation work – SDG&E will be conducting weekend work on the San Luis Rey substation on both Saturday, May 13 and Sunday, May 14 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Crews will try to keep noise to a minimum.

Public Works

Pier View Way Bridge Concrete Patching Project – Work is almost complete on the southeast quadrant of the structure and the contractor is cleaning up the area this week. Work on the last quadrant (southwest) will be delayed until after summer to make way for the beach crowds arriving by Memorial Day weekend. The work on the first 3 quadrants took longer than expected as the extent of repairs was very difficult to estimate.



New Parking Meter Rate – Staff is initiating the rate change for the parking meters today from \$1.00 per hour to the new rate of \$1.50 per hour. The new parking rates were previously approved at City Council on April 5. This work will likely take a couple of weeks to complete due to the number of parking meters.
