Planning

Planning Commission meeting on 6/12/17 was cancelled.

Harbor

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Harbor Dredging Project – To date, Manson Construction has dredged 405,000 cubic yards of sand with 15,000 cubic yards to go to completion. The deadline for dredging operations is Monday, June 12.

Oceanside Police and Neighborhood Services Department

More Help for Homeless: Interfaith Community Services will provide case management services for the Homeless Outreach Team (HOT) and Section 8 participants from July 1, 2017, to June 30, 2018. The Social Worker will have extensive training in mental health and substance use disorders, and be trained and experienced in verbal de-escalation techniques to better support the HOT officer's mission. City staff and the Social Worker will work together to offer mainstream resources, veteran resources, and temporary housing for the homeless when available. The Social Worker will have fixed office hours at the Housing Authority (4-8 hours a week) that will allow Section 8 participants needing referrals and resources to meet with them.

A flex fund will be established to bridge the needs of the homeless with resources that are not available through mainstream social services. Once the homeless individual has been screened for the appropriate intervention, he/she will be escorted and/or referred to the resource location. The Social Worker assistance would include working with landlords, assisting to set up a household and providing counseling/mentoring regarding life skills to include paying bills on time and maintaining a rental unit. OPD and the Neighborhood Services Department have agreed to share the cost for this endeavor.

Water Utilities

Citywide Solar - Construction began Monday, June 5, 2017, on the re-roofing project at the Police Main Building on Mission Avenue. Once complete, the Police Department will have a completely new roof with a 25-year warranty. This project is being performed at no cost to the City as part of the City-wide solar project by PFMG Solar, LLC. Once complete, the roof will be ready to accept solar panels, as part of phase 2 of the solar project. The construction is estimated to take approximately 8 weeks to complete, with final inspections in late July.

Agritourism Workshop #3 will occur on June 15, 2017, at the San Luis Rey Water Reclamation Facility, 3950 N. Rivers Road, from 8:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Breakfast and lunch will be served. The 3rd Workshop is being held to assist land owners who are interested in starting an agritourism activity on their property. The agenda is filled with guest speakers sharing the opportunities and challenges of operating an agritourism businesses, guidance on navigating regulations and permitting, marketing strategies, and will conclude with attendees creating a one-page business plan. The hope is to have several agritourism activities occur in South Morro Hills, such as wineries, bed and breakfasts, farm-to-table events, farm stand operations and other creative ideas that would bring economic activity and generate interest in the agricultural area of Oceanside.
