# CITY COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE June 29, 2017

### **Planning**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, June 26, 2017.

#### **PUBLIC HEARINGS**

RANCHO DEL ORO CONGREGATION OF JEHOVAH'S WITNESS, INC. – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP17-00004) to allow continued operation of a religious assembly use and modify hours of operation for an existing church facility located within an existing industrial building at 1930 Avenida Del Oro. *The Commission approved the project and adopted the resolution by a 5-2 vote (Busk, Krahel – No). The call for review/appeal ends on July 6, 2017.* 

1709 SO. PACIFIC REMODEL – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC16-00014) to allow the remodel of, and addition to, an existing single-family residence at 1709 South Pacific Street. This item was removed from the agenda – will be re-noticed and re-scheduled for a future hearing.

---1763 YUCCA ROAD – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP17-00006) to allow a modification and reconfiguration of lots through a lot line adjustment and permit panhandle access to Parcels 2, 3, and 4 from Yucca Road and to exceed the base density of 1.0 dwelling units per gross acre with a density of 2.3 dwelling units per acre. *The Commission approved the project and adopted the resolution by a 6-1 vote (Scrivener – No). The call for review/appeal ends on July 6, 2017.*

#### <u>Fire</u>

**REACH Air Ambulance** - After several years of planning and construction, REACH Air Ambulance moved from the Oceanside Airport to the Oceanside Fire Department Training Center on Monday, June 26. We have two aeromedical providers in the city. Mercy Air is currently based out of the Oceanside Airport. While landing zones for helicopters may be designated at ad-hoc locations, we have four secured designated helipads in the City of Oceanside. These are located at the Oceanside Airport, the OFD Training Center on Jones Road, Fire Station 5 off of North River Road, and at Tri-City Hospital.

## **Neighborhood Services**

**National Night Out** will be held on August 1, 2017. National Night Out (NNO) is a community-building campaign that promotes police-community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie to make our neighborhoods a safer, better place to live. NNO enhances the relationship between neighbors and law enforcement while bringing back a true sense of community and provides a great opportunity to bring police and neighbors together under positive circumstances.

Four neighborhoods across Oceanside will host community events with youth activities, visits from public safety personnel, movies in the parks, and/or basketball tournaments. The Oceanside locations participating in this year's annual campaign are:

- Crown Heights Resource Center will feature the movie "Moana" from 5:00 8:00 p.m.
- John Landes Park will host youth activities and a basketball tournament from 5:00 8:00 p.m.
- Joe Balderrama Park will feature the "Lego Batman Movie" from 5:00 9:00 p.m.
- Libby Lake Park will show the "Lego Batman Movie" from 7:00 9:00 p.m.

**California Youth Soccer and Recreation Development Program grant application update -** Neighborhood Services Department staff have received notification from the State of California Department of Parks & Recreation (DPR) that the City of Oceanside was not selected among awardees for the California Youth Soccer and Recreation Development Programs FY 2017-19 grant. California DPR received 166 applications requesting a total of \$134,893,005 from throughout the state. California DPR had \$16 million available for grants. All proposals underwent a competitive review process and were scored based on criteria that included community challenges, project benefits, and demographic information using the California State Parks Community Fact Finder – Youth Soccer tool. As a result, only 25 proposals were awarded throughout California. Staff were able to obtain verbal feedback as to the rating and scoring of our application. DPR staff indicated the City of Oceanside's proposal was strong with one exception, a relatively low unemployment rate of 8.1% for the Eastside community, as compared to other applicants. State DPR provided City staff with additional grant opportunities to pursue to benefit the Balderrama Soccer Field project or other park improvements. #### **Water Utilities**

**Independence Parade -** Green Oceanside is participating in the Independence Day Parade on July 1 as they debut the new 100% electric outreach van, along with the Waste Management mini truck. The outreach van is wrapped to provide enhanced community engagement and awareness of the City's environmental programs such as Zero Waste, Clean Water, Water and Energy Conservation and Climate Action.

**OUSD Summer Meal Program Kick Off -** The Green Oceanside team participated in the two Summer Meal Program kick off events sponsored by Oceanside Unified School District and the San Diego Hunger Coalition. Over 500 members of the East Side and Crown Heights communities participated at Balderrama Park last Thursday while approximately 20 vendors

provided information on a variety of available services. On Thursday June 29, a similar event was held at Libby Lake Park.
