### <u>Planning</u>

#### **Planning Commission**

The July 24 Planning Commission meeting was cancelled.

**North River Farms Project -** The applicant recently submitted applications for a Tentative Map, Development Plan and a revised Planned Development zoning. Reports concerning traffic, biology and environmental assessments were also provided. Applications for a General Plan amendment and Zone amendment to Planned Development had already been submitted. City staff is reviewing the entire application submittal. The following table compares the prior and recent proposals:

- A. Review and Recommendation of a one-year time extension for the previously approved project Portola Mixed-Use located at the northwest corner of Pier View Way and North Horne Street (REXT17-00001, T-203-04, D-211-04) *Recommend approval 6-1* (Bockman-NO)
- B. Review and Recommendation of a four-unit condominium complex located at 150 South Myers Street (RP16-00002, RD16-00004, RRP16-00006) *Recommend approval 5-2 (Bockman and Hankins-NO)*
- C. Review and Recommendation of amending Section 1232 (E) of the Downtown Zoning Ordinance and to permit a single-family residential subdivision for the development of two rowhomes located at 522 North Tremont Street (RZA17-00001, RLCPA17-0000, RP17-00001, RD17-00001, RRP17-00001) *Recommend approval with revision 4-3 (Higgins, Wright, and Andrioff-NO)*
- D. Review and Recommendation of amending portions of the Downtown Zoning Ordinance text to allow multi-family residential development within D13 Subdistrict (RZA17-00002, RLCPA17-00002) *Recommend approval 7-0*

### **Public Works**

**Army Corps of Engineers Sediment Removal Project -** The Corps received the 401 certification from the San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board (final permit) last Thursday and is expecting to take bids on July 27, 2017. The project is still tentatively scheduled to begin construction in early September, 2017 depending on the outcome of the bids. City staff will soon begin making minor improvements to the "Drive In" site property which will be used as part of the bike trail detour. Signs will also be placed along the entire detour route. Beach quality sand will be placed on Oceanside beaches from Seagaze Drive to Pine Street and from Oceanside Boulevard to Buccaneer Beach.

**Vegetation Clearing (Country Club Lane canyon between Senior Center and I-5)** – Staff is working with OPD, Code Enforcement and two contractors on this clearing project being done as a fire prevention measure as this area has become very overgrown. Staff hired a biologist to perform bird surveys and a biological assessment of this City property this week. The completed biological survey is required before beginning non-native vegetation clearing which will start next week.

#### **Economic Development**

**A Cal Competes "GoBiz" Workshop** was held at the Oceanside Chamber of Commerce on July 21 to assist local businesses with the application process for a California State tax credit. About 30 businesses attended the workshop. Cal Competes offers State tax credits to companies that are expanding in California by adding employees, machinery, or buildings. This round is offering \$75 million in tax credits to eligible companies.
