Public Works

Vegetation Clearing (Country Club Lane canyon between Senior Center and I-5) — The biological survey was completed last week and non-native vegetation clearing began this week along with selected hand clearing. An industrial tractor equipped with a hydraulic mulching head was brought in on Wednesday to clear the most dense areas of vegetation. This project involves removing overgrown brush as a fire prevention and vector control



measure and should be completed by the end of the week.

Water Utilities

Solar Project - Staff is working closely with the solar contractors to make sure everything continues to move forward. The solar modules were delivered to an offsite location last week and the contractor's electricians have performed multiple site visits gaining access to the electrical panels at the various sites. Construction for Phase 1 will begin at Fire Station #7, Melba Bishop, and the El Corazon Senior Center on 8/7/17 and at the COC on 8/21/17. The fences will go back up Melba Bishop at the end of next week. All affected Departments will be updated regarding construction so that they may plan accordingly for parking. The two new roofs at the police station are near completion. The plans for Phase 2 will be submitted to the Building Department on Tuesday 8/1/17. Phase 2 construction is currently scheduled to begin at Fire Stations #4 and #6 on 9/4/17, and Jones Rd. and MLK Park on 9/11/17, pending permit approvals. The MLK parking lot is scheduled to be completely shut down from 9/11/17 – 10/26/17. Additional banners, posters, and flyers have been developed and will be posted at the various sites, including banners at MLK Jr. Middle School and Ivey Ranch Elementary School informing the public the Solar Project is "Coming Soon." Staff is coordinating with Parks on these efforts.

Neighborhood Services

Alliance for Regional Solutions: North County Cities Working to Address

Homelessness - The Regional Taskforce on the Homeless (RTFH) is creating a Community Plan, which will identify exactly what is needed to effectively end homelessness in San Diego County. RTFH administers the annual homeless count, the regional homeless database, the Coordinated Entry System for homeless services, and distributes federal HUD funding locally. The RFTH Community Plan Committee is being chaired by the North County Alliance for Regional Solutions Board President and CEO, Greg Anglea. Phase 1 of the Community Plan will be released in August 2017. At that time, Greg will be sharing the plan with North County Mayors and City staff in August. Phase 2 of the Community Plan will quantify specifics; in the meantime, we need to work together to increase resources now, including more permanent supportive housing, more affordable housing, rapid rehousing resources, support services and landlord outreach and incentives.
