# CITY COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE August 24, 2017

#### **Planning**

Planning Commission meeting on 8/28/17 is cancelled.

**Economic Development Element** (EDE) – Staff is refining draft EDE goals and policies for EDC review on September 12. After EDC input, an EDE public workshop will be scheduled for late October/early November. In addition to goals and policies, staff has prepared most of the background material for this element.

**Energy/Climate Action Element (ECAP)** - RECON Environmental has prepared a draft Climate Action Plan that provides the basis for climate-related goals and policies. In the next few weeks, Planning staff will be convening staff in various City disciplines (e.g., Public Works, Water Utilities) to review the draft Green House Gas reduction measures. Through SANDAG's Climate Framework, staff is commissioning a cost/benefit analysis of our draft reduction measures. This analysis will be conducted at no cost to the City. **Community Choice Energy (CCE) -** The City continues to monitor the CCE efforts in the county. As of the first week of August, the City of Encinitas staff is drafting a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a CCE Technical Feasibility Study. Oceanside staff as well as staff from the cities of Del Mar and Carlsbad will have an opportunity to provide comment on the RFP before it goes out for response, likely sometime in late September early October. Based on the proposals/bids received and selection of a consultant, the interested cities can negotiate a final cost share agreement. Any agreement would need to be approved by the City Council.
