CITY COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE November 16, 2017

Planning

The November 20, 2017 PC meeting has been cancelled.

Buena Vista Lagoon Joint Powers Commission/EIR - SANDAG issued the Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) on 10/27/17 with the saltwater alternative as their proposed project. SANDAG expects to bring the Final EIR to the SANDAG Board of Directors for consideration and certification in December, 2017 or January, 2018. Draft Economic Development Element (EDE) Public Workshop – Nov. 29 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers. The first hour of the workshop will follow an open house format, with participants invited to circulate among staffed stations presenting components of the Draft EDE, summaries of public input and technical study findings, and map exhibits that illustrate the City's capacity for additional commercial and industrial activity. The second hour will involve two short presentations and a whole-group question and answer session. Participants will be encouraged to share ideas for implementing draft EDE policies.

Planning Division staff will schedule one-on-one briefings with City Councilmembers to share draft EDE themes, goals, and policies.

Public Works

Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the Coast Highway Corridor Study – The DEIR public review period ended August 28, 2017, and the consultant along with staff are addressing comments. CalTrans stated the on and off ramps at Interstate 5 should be analyzed as part of the study and staff is currently negotiating the extra work with the consultant to determine cost. Staff hopes to settle on the additional scope of work and price by early December. The goal is to bring this item to City Council in early 2018.

Temporary Art Display at Oceanside Museum of Art - The Oceanside Museum of Art (OMA) has recently put up a temporary art display covering most of the front of the building. The art display represents a "border wall" made of treated corrugated metal. The art display will run through January 2018. The art display is part of a statewide art exhibition through the Getty Museum with art to be shown at more than 70 arts and cultural institutions across Southern California. The thematically linked exhibitions and programs highlight different aspects of Latin America and Latino art from the ancient world to present day.

Per the terms of the lease agreement between the City and OMA, OMA can temporarily display art on the building provided the display does not structurally impact the building. Accordingly, OMA met with the Building Division and had the structural specifications for the "border wall" art display approved. Additionally, the art display was provided to the Planning Division for their review and it was determined that there are no Planning permits needed for the temporary art display.
