Planning

PUBLIC HEARINGS

MCDONALD'S RENOVATION – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D15-00011) and CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP15-00008) to allow for the addition of 660 square feet of dining and indoor playground area and a façade renovation for an existing restaurant located at 1701 Oceanside Boulevard (APN: 151-310-19). *The commission approved the project by a 5-0 vote (Balma, Martinek – Absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on February 18, 2016.*

Engineering

Annual Overlay-The City's contractor is in the process of obtaining railroad crossing permits from the North County Transit District. Due to the locations and scope of the work, NCTD also requires increased insurance coverage from the City. Upon securing the permits and satisfying the insurance requirements, we plan to grind and pave El Camino Real between Fire Mountain Drive and Mesa Drive within a few weeks. Subsequently, we will pave portions of Surfrider Way and Pacific Street.

Oceanside Boulevard Paving - The City's contractor continues with microgrinding in order to remedy the unevenness of the road. Upon completion of this process, traffic detector loops will be installed and the striping will be finished.

Water Utilities

City Council Workshop March 9 at 2:00 p.m. - City Council Workshop regarding the potential of a single-use carryout bag ordinance in Oceanside. City staff will be providing a presentation and summary report of public comment received through a recent outreach and education public solicitation process on the issue of plastic bags and ordinance options for Oceanside.
