Planning

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Oceanside Historic Preservation Advisory Commission (OHPAC) reviewed and took action on at a special meeting on Tuesday, March 1, 2016.

PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS

VILLA STORIA PLANNING AREA 2A – Consideration of TENTATIVE MAP (T15-00007), DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D15-00018) and HISTORIC PERMIT (H15-00001) – A request to construct 52 three-story townhome condominium units with associated private street improvements, guest parking, private and common open space, and landscaping. The proposal is subject to the standards and guidelines of the Villa Storia Planned Development (PD) Plan. *The Commission adopted the resolution recommending approval by a 4-0 vote.*

Coast Highway Corridor Study Community Open House – Tuesday, March 15 between 5:30-7:30 in the Council Chambers. Arrive at your convenience anytime between 5:30-7:30, review preferred alternatives for segments along Coast Highway and provide your comments. <u>More information</u>

Annual Overlay-The City has obtained the necessary increased insurance coverage and NCTD permits for work in the railroad right of way. We plan to grind and pave El Camino Real between Fire Mountain Drive and Mesa Drive within a couple of weeks. Weather permitting, this will be nighttime work. Subsequently, we will pave portions of Surfrider Way and Pacific Street during daytime hours.

The Strand at Wisconsin Street- The City's contractor is coordinating with a private developer's work on the revetment to pave a portion of The Strand at Wisconsin Street. The first phase of base paving will occur by the end of this week.

Oceanside Boulevard Paving-The City's contractor is adjusting water valve cans and sewer manholes to the new pavement's surface. A subcontractor is installing traffic detector loops in order to place the signals back to their normal timing. Another subcontractor is continuing with pavement striping and marking. This work is performed at night.
