PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS

VILLA STORIA PLANNING AREA 2B — Consideration of a Development Plan (D15-00019) and Historic Permit (H15-00002) to allow 38 three-story income-restricted rental units and associated improvements on a 1.82-acre site within the Villa Storia Planned Development (PD) Plan Area. The proposed rental units would fulfill the inclusionary housing requirements of the previously approved Villa Storia project, which includes a total of 341 market-rate dwelling units. *The Commission approved Staff's recommendation for PC approval by a 3-0 vote (Daley – Absent) and adopted the resolution.*

VILLA STORIA PLANNING AREA 2B – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D15-00019)/HISTORIC PERMIT (H15-00002) to allow 38 three-story stacked flat income-restricted rental units within Planning Area 2B of the Villa Storia Planned Development (PD) Area, with associated private roadways, guest parking, common open space, and landscape. The project site is located within the San Luis Rey Neighborhood Planning Area and the Mission San Luis Rey Historic Overlay District. *Staff is recommending approval.*

Engineering

Annual Overlay - On El Camino Real, the City's contractor has finished utility adjustments, replaced pavement markers, and connected the new traffic detector loops.

On Surfrider Way and Pacific Street, the contractor has finished adjusting utilities and completed striping and pavement markings. They have also cleaned up the asphalt emulsion that was tracked on to adjacent streets during asphalt operations.
