PUBLIC HEARINGS

VILLA STORIA PLANNING AREA 2B – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D15-00019)/HISTORIC PERMIT (H15-00002) to allow 38 three-story stacked flat income-restricted rental units within Planning Area 2B of the Villa Storia Planned Development (PD) Area, with associated private roadways, guest parking, common open space, and landscape. Lying to the northeast of the intersection of Mission Avenue and Academy Road, the project site is located within the San Luis Rey Neighborhood Planning Area and the Mission San Luis Rey Historic Overlay District. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution with revisions. The call for review/appeal period ends on May 19, 2016.*

Neighborhood Services

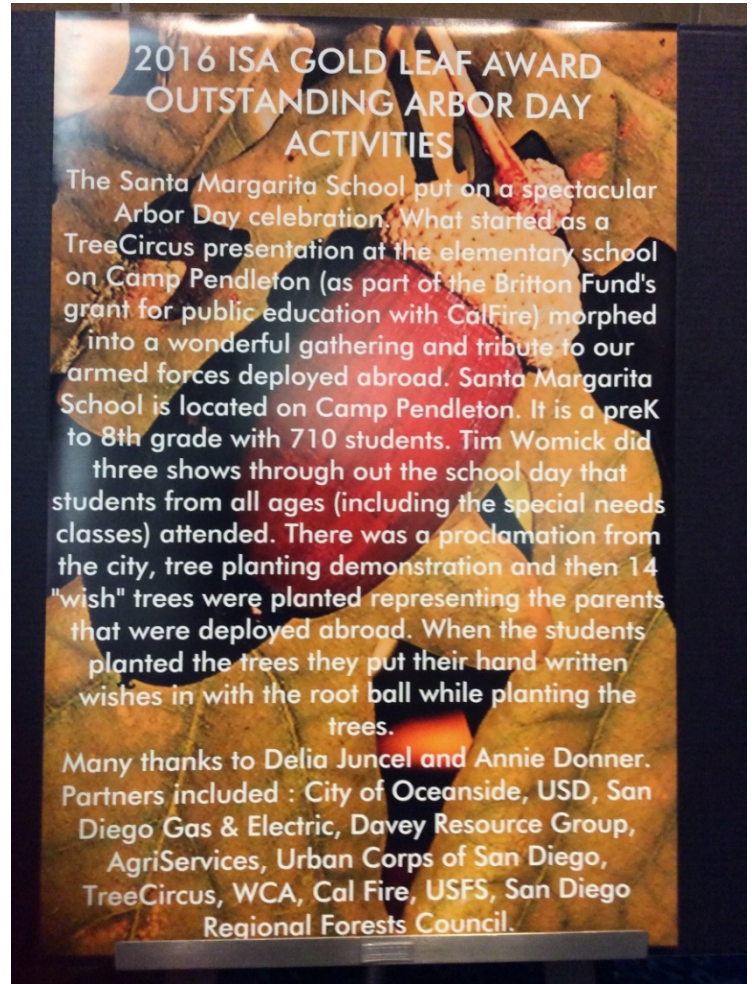
