Planning

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, July 11, 2016.

TRANSPORTATION ITEMS

Request to establish Permit Parking on Moreno Street per the Preferential Parking Permit Program. *Staff is recommending approval (to City Council).*

PUBLIC HEARINGS

PACIFIC TERRACE ROOF DECKS – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D16-00003) and REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC16-00004) to modify an approved 38-unit condominium development in order to incorporate individual rooftop decks for each townhome located at 514 Morse Street. *Staff is recommending approval.*

PACIFIC TERRACE TIME EXTENSION – Consideration of a TENTATIVE PARCEL MAP EXTENSION (T13-00008), DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D13-00004), CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP13-00009) and REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC13-00003) to allow a two-year extension for a previously approved 38-condominium townhome development on a 2.3-acre site located at the northeast corner of Morse Street and South Coast Highway. *Staff is recommending approval.*

Discussion and comment on Draft Mural Policy.

City Manager's Office

Army Corps of Engineers Dredging Project - Dredging in the Harbor entrance area resumed on Wednesday, July 6 and is operating with the new water jet equipment in place at approximately 5,000 cubic yards per 24 hour period. The dredging contractor (CJW) obtained a new mooring system allowing operations in wave heights of 4-5 feet, up from 3 feet previously. The contractor estimates mobilizing additional pipe sections south of North Coast Village (NCV) on July 12-15; pipe to be initially buried in front of NCV but ocean conditions could expose the pipe.

The City received a letter from Col. Gibbs with the Army Corps in response to the Mayor's letters about the City's dissatisfaction with the 2016 dredging project. Col. Gibbs stated that the Army Corps expects the project to be completed by August 10 unless delayed by adverse ocean conditions. He further stated that they have addressed the safety concerns with the contractor and corrective action has been taken. The City Manager spoke with the Corps' Western Region head Civilian on Wednesday and strongly reiterated the City's displeasure and requested that the Corps: 1) locate a more experienced contractor for next year and 2) ensure that dredging

be completed by Memorial Day in 2017. The Corps indicated that they will be providing weekly updates via press releases for the Council and the community.
