### <u>Planning</u>

Planning Commission meeting scheduled for 7/25/16 has been cancelled.

#### <u>Harbor</u>

Army Corps of Engineers Dredging Project - While not operating today, dredging in the Harbor entrance area has continued with the new water jet equipment in place that has achieved a rate exceeding 9,000 cubic yards in one 24-hour period. The dredging contractor CJW Construction (CJW) obtained a new four anchor/cable mooring system that has allowed dredging operations in wave heights of greater than 3 feet. The total amount of sand dredged to date is approximately 70,000 cubic yards out of a project goal of 260,000 cubic yards.

The contractor has extended their pipe; the end of the pipe is now near The Roberts' Cottages.
