Planning

Planning Commission meeting scheduled for 7/25/16 was cancelled.

Harbor

Army Corps of Engineers Dredging Project - The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) contracted this year with CJW Construction, Inc. to perform the annual Oceanside Harbor Entrance Channel dredging job the objective of which is to maintain a safe, navigable Harbor entrance.

Fortunately, the sand dredged from the mouth of the Harbor is being placed on Oceanside's beaches. The contractor is currently working to complete a channel within the Harbor Entrance that will be to the anticipated depth; following that, they will continue their work to accomplish this year's complete dredging plan.

CJW has completed 75,800 cubic yards of material so far, out of the 260,000 cubic yards needed to make the Harbor entrance safe for both the Navy and recreational and commercial boaters. The dredge has experienced several mechanical issues that have caused multiple delays on this project; this has resulted in the extension of the expected completion date into September, per the USACE.

Neighborhood Services

Family Self-Sufficiency Coordinator Funding Award - The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has notified the City of an award of \$68,680 to pay the salary of a Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Coordinator in the Neighborhood Services Department for calendar year 2017. The FSS Program has been available to households participating in the City's Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Program since 1993. Families in the program execute a contract that specifies goals and services; the contract requires that all members become independent of welfare and maintain suitable employment. The FSS Coordinator ensures that the program participants are linked to the supportive services they need to achieve self-sufficiency.
