Planning

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, January 26, 2015.

PREMIERE PATIO PROPANE – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP14-00010) to allow the installation and use of a 30,000-gallon above ground and outdoor propane storage tank. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on February 5, 2015.

T-MOBILE @ 851-a WILSHIRE ROAD — Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP14-00019) to allow the continued operation of a wireless telecommunication facility at 851-A Wilshire Road (Mellano Farms). The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 vote (Ross — No) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on February 5, 2015.

REACH AIR – Consideration of DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D13-00017) and CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP13-00036) to permit the operation and construction of a helipad for emergency air transportation services with an associated 1,872 square-foot modular crew trailer at 110 Jones Road. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on February 5, 2015.

Citywide LED Street Light Retrofit Project: 99% of the 7,700 street lights (Phase I) have been installed with adaptive controls to date. Southern Contracting is waiting on the last shipment of product to complete the project and then GE will begin testing the lighting control system. The City has qualified for all of the SDG&E rebates. The style/type/color of the Phase II lights (parks, parking lots, post tops, etc...) is being finalized and we expect to make an order in early February which will take approximately 8-12 weeks to arrive. We anticipate completing this portion of the project by early summer, 2015.
