## CITY COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE February 27, 2015

# **Planning**

**Planning Commission:** Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, February 23, 2015.

MITCHELL RESIDENCE – Consideration of a VARIANCE (V14-00004) to allow the construction of a single-family home with a reduced interior side yard setback on a vacant property located at 1502 Brooks Street (APN 150-335-30-00). The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution. *The call for review/appeal period ends on March 5, 2015.* 

VERIZON @ 547 VISTA BELLA – Consideration of an ADMINISTRATIVE CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (ACUP14-00012) to upgrade and continue operation of an existing wireless communication facility at 547 Vista Bella. The City Planner's approval of the project has been appealed and the decision is subject to a public hearing. *The Commission voted 7-0 to continue this item to the March 23, 2015 Planning Commission public hearing.* 

#### **DISCUSSION ITEMS:** RESIDENTIAL PARKING STANDARDS IN THE COASTAL ZONE *Item discussed; Commission provided conceptual support of staff recommendation, expressed concern with eliminating lift and tandem parking, and requested additional information concerning other jurisdictions when staff returns.*

- Oceanside Tattoo and Museum consideration of a Use Permit and Coastal Permit to allow a tattoo establishment, including 7 tattoo stations and 1 body-piercing station, and a tattoo museum within an existing 1,128 square foot commercial tenant space located at 212 North Coast Highway.
