TRANSPORTATION ITEMS

REQUEST FOR AN ALL-WAY STOP AT HORNE STREET AND PIER VIEW WAY. ***The Commission approved staff's recommendation by a 6-0 vote (Ross – Absent) recommending approval to the City Council.***

APPEAL OF CITY PLANNER'S DETERMINATION

VERIZON @ 547 VISTA BELLA – Consideration of an ADMINISTRATIVE CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (ACUP14-00012) to upgrade and continue operation of an existing wireless communication facility at 547 Vista Bella.
