It is the policy of the City Council, serving as the Community Development Commission, to generally not support alley vacations. However, if a property owner can demonstrate that a superior project, benefiting the neighborhood in which the project is located, can only be achieved by the vacation of an alley, the vacation request will <u>only</u> be considered if it meets <u>all</u> the following criteria:

- 1. Any proposed vacation shall consist of an entire alley.
- 2. All proposed development projects must demonstrate that service vehicles will have access to the affected project or property, and that the subject vacation shall not serve as a detriment to any affected property owner.
- 3. Each project and subject vacation must provide appropriate access for trash pickup, loading, delivery, pedestrians and internal vehicle circulation.
- 4. The relocation of associated utility service lines in the subject alley should be considered on the basis of each individual project or vacation proposal.
- 5. A vacation plan depicting the above conditions must be submitted and approved by the City Planner and City Engineer prior to submission to the CDC.
- 6. Alley vacations will only occur if and when the approved project is constructed, and not before.
