WESTFIELD CARLSBAD MALL GROUND SIGN – Consideration of a VARIANCE (V14-00002) to allow the construction of a replacement ground sign over 30 feet in height and over 300 square feet in sign area on a 10.42-acre lot located at the northern limit of the Westfield Carlsbad Mall parking lot. *Staff is recommending approval.*
