Planning

The 5/18/15 Planning Commission meeting has been cancelled.

Building

- Building Safety staff hosted a regional solar energy seminar on Tuesday, May 12 at the Civic Center. Approximately 100 people from the region attended with representatives from government, industry and contractors participating. The pre-lunch training involved an actual roof top solar installation constructed on site for the event.
- Olli Salumeria has a new ground up facility at 1301 Rocky Point Drive that is nearing completion. The building is 84,000 sq. ft. with new offices and manufacturing for the gourmet salami manufacturer. Final approvals from the USDA are ongoing with opening anticipated in the next few weeks.
- First Park at Ocean Ranch consisting of 3 new tilt up concrete buildings is under construction. The project will provide an additional 240,000 sq. ft. of commercial/industrial space on Ocean Ranch Boulevard.
- Fed Ex is currently under construction with concrete footings at this time.
