Engineering

Traffic Engineering

The Transportation Engineering Division has been successful in applying and receiving SANDAG grant funding for the Seagaze Drive Downtown Mobility Project (constructing bulb-outs on all the corners on Seagaze between Freeman and Clementine, and a crosswalk with flashing beacons by the Senior Housing); and Bike/Bus Safety Public Outreach Project (which will pay for bus wraps on approximately 15 NCTD buses to help educate people on bike safety).

Annual Overlay Program - Resurfacing of the ECR/Vista Way Intersection - Work to overlay El Camino Real at Vista Way and at HWY 78 started last week. Paving of Vista Way from El Camino Real to Via Esmarca was completed on 6/24. The work continues with raising utilities. New striping is scheduled for completion before the July 4th weekend. In addition to the asphalt work, the traffic signals have been converted from loops to video detection.
