### CITY COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE September 17, 2015

### **Planning**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, September 14, 2015.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING**

STIRLING DEVELOPMENT – Consideration of a Tentative Parcel Map (P15-00003) to subdivide an existing 10.19 acre parcel into three parcels including two parcels for future development and one parcel for public right-of-way (ROW). The public right-of-way (ROW) parcel would accommodate planned Street "B" improvements envisioned by the El Corazon Specific Plan. The project does not include a proposed development plan at this time and future development of the parcels will be subject to the City's discretionary and/or legislative review process based on the nature of proposed development at that time. The subject property is situated along the west side of Rancho del Oro Road opposite Ocean Ranch Boulevard. *The Commission approved the project by a 5-0 vote (Balma – Absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on September 24, 2015.* 

OCEANSIDE OPPORTUNISTIC BEACH FILL PROGRAM — Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC15-00009) for approval to renew and amend the City of Oceanside's Opportunistic Beach Fill Program (OBFP) for a period of 5 years. The purpose of the City's amended OBFP is to continue to facilitate the timely approval for placement of beach-quality sand on City beaches as suitable material becomes available. The amended Opportunistic Beach Fill Program (OBFP) area would cover two placement areas covering a total of approximately 3,600 feet of the public beach shoreline between Seagaze Drive and Pine Street, and between Oceanside Boulevard to the river mouth of Loma Alta Creek at the north end of Buccaneer Beach. *The Commission approved the project by a 5-0 vote (Balma – Absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on September 24, 2015.* 

#### **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

VINE STREET COLLECTION PROJECT – Conceptual review and comment on a proposed project consisting of 56 residential townhomes (condominium units) within eight 3-story buildings on a 6.3 acre parcel located west of Vine Street across from the Best Western Oceanside Inn and north of Oceanside Blvd., involving a General Plan Amendment from General Commercial to Residential Medium Density B and a Zoning Amendment from Commercial Recreation (CR) to Medium Residential B (RM-B 10-15 D.U./acre). *Item discussed.*
