Annual Overlay - The City's contractor is in the process of obtaining railroad crossing permits from the North County Transit District. Upon securing the permits, we plan to pave El Camino Real between Fire Mountain Drive and Mesa Drive after the holidays.

Oceanside Boulevard Paving - The City is in the process of contracting with an engineering consultant to quantitatively test the road's roughness. The contractor will be directed to remedy unevenness at the determined locations.

Water Utilities

Staff will be commencing the community outreach process for the single-use bag issue and have confirmed and agendaized the following "Single Use Bag Ban" presentations/workshops for the month of January. Following the community input process, staff will provide an update to the Utilities Commission in February and introduce a community framed ordinance for Council consideration in March. Oceanside Deployment Site for WeALLCOUNT census of homeless persons - Friday, January 29, 2016 at the El Corazon Senior Center - The Regional Task Force on the Homeless (RTFH) coordinates an annual one day census of the people in San Diego County experiencing homelessness, both sheltered and unsheltered; more than 1,000 volunteers will be trained and deployed throughout the county. The count is mandated for all communities funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. It enables our region to better understand the scope, impact and potential solutions to homelessness; and empowers our community to qualify for funding that is essential to addressing the issue. Communities across the country will be conducting similar events during the last ten days of January. This year the count will take place on Friday, January 29, 2016 between 4:00 and 7:00 a.m.

For the third year, the City of Oceanside will host a deployment center at the El Corazon Senior Center located at 3302 Senior Center Drive. Volunteers will arrive at 4:00 a.m. and be provided with maps of areas that they will survey. Results of the survey will be published by the Task Force at a later date.
