Planning Division

Development Services

Mission Avenue Improvement Project Phase 1

Construction: Work on the Mission Avenue Improvement Project continues as planned. On Monday, January 6, 2014, concrete traffic barriers and traffic control was placed west of Ditmar to Coast Highway on the north side of Mission Ave. Ditmar and Freeman Streets are closed to through traffic north of Mission Avenue. Pedestrian access is being provided to all businesses along this segment while construction is underway. Demolition of sidewalks and removal of palm trees and street lights were completed this week. Asphalt removal will take place next week. This stage of the project is scheduled to be complete April 2014.

Farmers' Market: The Farmers' Market was relocated from Freeman Street west to Tremont Street on Pier View Way. The temporary relocation of the Farmers' Market will last until April 2014, and then will return to its normal location. Staff is monitoring pedestrian and traffic flows.
