Development Services

Mission Avenue Improvement Project

Construction: During the week of April 21-25, minor work will continue in Stage 2 as the contractor performs the major Stage 3 work of reconstructing the sidewalks and pavement. To maintain traffic through the intersection of Mission Avenue and Coast Highway, work will progress in sub-stages during Stage 3.

- The reconstruction of the sidewalks will begin as the contractor lays out the new curbs, planter boxes and crosswalks along the south side of Mission Avenue from Clementine to Ditmar.
- Traffic will continue north and south on Coast Highway in the outside lanes as concrete crosswalks and asphalt is placed for the inside lanes at the intersection of Mission and Coast Highway.

Business Relations: Staff communication with MSO will continue, the effects of Stage 3 will be discussed with businesses along Mission Avenue, and notifications on future stage transitions will be distributed as necessary.
