# CITY COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE April 24, 2014

## **Planning Division**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, April 21, 2014:

DRIVEWAY @ 1601 SOUTH NEVADA – Adoption of Planning Commission Resolution No. 2014-P07 approving a VARIANCE (V13-00007) to allow two curb-cuts and driveways on a single-family residential property located at 1601 South Nevada Street. *The Commission adopted the resolution by a 5-2 vote (Troisi, Balma – No). The call for review/appeal period ends on May 1, 2014.* 

1735 S. PACIFIC ST. REMODEL – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC13-00011) to remodel an existing single-family residence located at 1735 South Pacific Street. *Item has been removed from the agenda and will be re-notice and re-schedule for a future hearing* 

NEW SONG COMMUNITY CHURCH – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP13-00011) and HISTORIC PERMIT (H13-00003) to allow continued operation of a religious assembly use and minor interior modifications to an existing church facility at 3985 Mission Avenue. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on May 1, 2014.

Commissioner Neal was selected as Chairperson and Commissioner Louise Balma was selected as Vice Chair for the next term (May 1, 2014 – April 30, 2015).

**Harbor Dredging** - Due to the forecast of high surf, the Harbor dredging operations will be suspended for approximately 5 days beginning Saturday morning, April 26. The dredging equipment will be moored at the south end of the Harbor entrance. It is estimated that the dredging will be completed on May 1.

## **Mission Avenue Improvement Project**

**Construction:** Work on the project continues. Demolition work and utility undergrounding from Clementine to Ditmar (Construction Stage 3) have been completed. This week (April 21 - April 25) rough grading and the forming and pouring of curb and gutter is the primary focus. Next week (April 28 – May 2) street light pole foundations and grading for sidewalk are scheduled to be completed. Pedestrian access to businesses will remain open at all times.

• Starting Monday, April 28, Construction Stage 4 from Ditmar to Coast Highway on the south side of Mission Avenue will start. Concrete barriers, traffic control and construction

fencing will be established. The demolition of sidewalks, curb and gutter and asphalt will follow. Pedestrian access to businesses will remain open at all times.

**Business Relations:** Main Street Oceanside, Arcadis and City staff continues to communicate with businesses. The next Main Street Oceanside Meeting is scheduled for May 5. A project update will be given to the group. Flyers continue to be distributed to businesses on upcoming project events.
