CITY COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE May 1, 2014

Planning Division

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, May 5, 2014:

PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS

BAJA BODY – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC14-00003) and CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP14-00008) to allow a commercial recreation use in an existing commercial building at 1220 South Coast Highway. *Staff is recommending approval.*

OCEANS 11 CASINO ADDITION – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP13-00027) to consider business operation modifications and update conditions of project approval for the Oceans 11 Casino (D-18-92, C-7-94, C-19-94, C-7-94REV07) at 121 Brooks Street. *Staff is recommending approval.*

MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES – Consideration of a ZONE AMENDMENT (ZA13-00005) to consider a Zone Amendment request to amend the City's 1992 Zoning Ordinance to: 1) add "Medical Marijuana Dispensaries" as a new land use within Article 4; and 2) adding Section 3043 "Medical Marijuana Dispensaries" for the purpose of establishing regulations and performance standards to Article 30 "Site Regulations". The proposed zoning text amendments related to "Medical Marijuana Dispensaries" would modify zoning standards throughout the City of Oceanside with the exception of those portions of the City within the Coastal Zone and the Downtown District. **Staff is recommending denial.**

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Discussion of proposed Capital Improvement Program (CIP) for FY 2014-2015 for the City of Oceanside. *Staff is recommending approval.*

Harbor Dredging - It is estimated that the dredging will be completed on Saturday, May 3, and the contractor should have all of its equipment removed by May 15, 2014.

Development Services

Mission Avenue Improvement Project

Construction: Work on the project continues. From Clementine to Ditmar (Construction Stage 3) rough grading, utility undergrounding and curb and gutter placement have been completed. On Monday, April 28, Construction Stage 4 from Ditmar to Coast Highway on the south side of Mission Avenue began. Concrete barriers, traffic control and construction fencing was placed. Demolition of sidewalks, curb and gutter and asphalt started as well. Next week (May 5 – May 9) sidewalks will be placed from Clementine to Ditmar. From Ditmar to Coast Highway rough grading will take place. Work on the southwest corner of Coast Highway and Mission will be complete. Pedestrian access to businesses will remain open at all times.

Business Relations: Main Street Oceanside, Arcadis and City staff continues to communicate with businesses. The next Main Street Oceanside meeting is scheduled for May 6. A project update will be given to the group. Flyers continue to be distributed to businesses on upcoming project events.

Coast Highway Corridor Study – A public workshop will be held on May 15, 2014, from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Attendees will learn about the menu of options available to enhance Coast Highway as a complete street, and be provided an opportunity to suggest types of improvements that are appropriate for the corridor.
