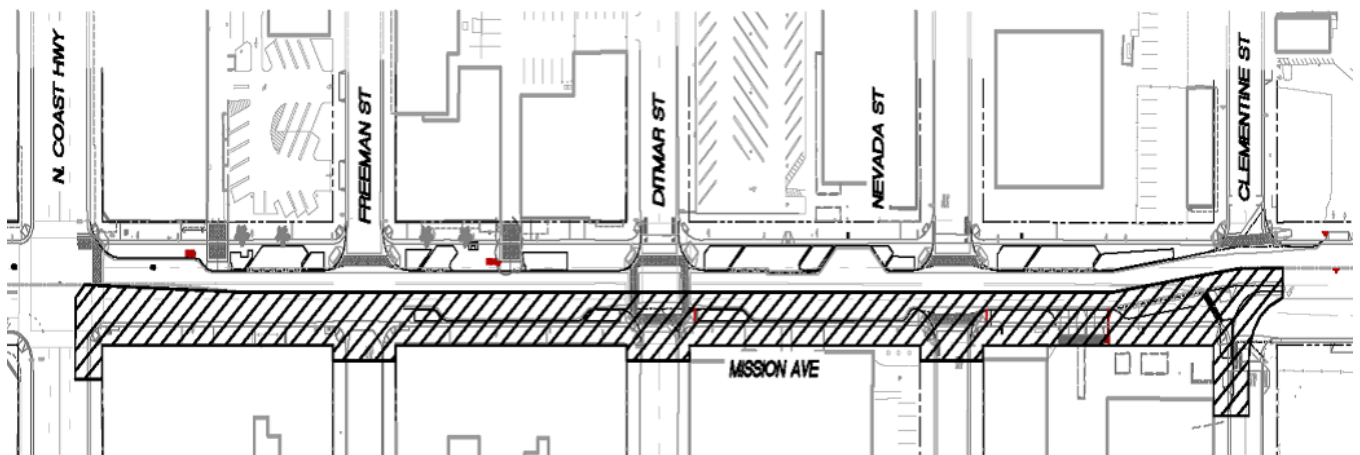
None – Planning Commission meeting on May 19, 2014 has been cancelled.

**Development Services**

**Mission Avenue Improvement Project**

**Construction:** Construction Stage 3 and Construction Stage 4 (from Clementine to Coast Highway) are both currently under construction (as shown below). This week (May 12-16), sidewalks were completed from Clementine to Ditmar. The traffic signal at Ditmar and Mission was completed. Storm drain installation started from Ditmar to Coast Highway. Work on the southwest corner of Coast Highway and Mission was completed and was opened to traffic on May 12. Next week (May 19-23), intersection work on the northwest corner of Coast Highway and Mission will continue. Grading and asphalt paving work from Clementine to Ditmar will be completed. Storm drain installation will continue between Ditmar and Coast Highway. Pedestrian access to businesses will remain open at all times.

**Business Relations:** Main Street Oceanside, Arcadis and City staff continues to communicate with businesses.
