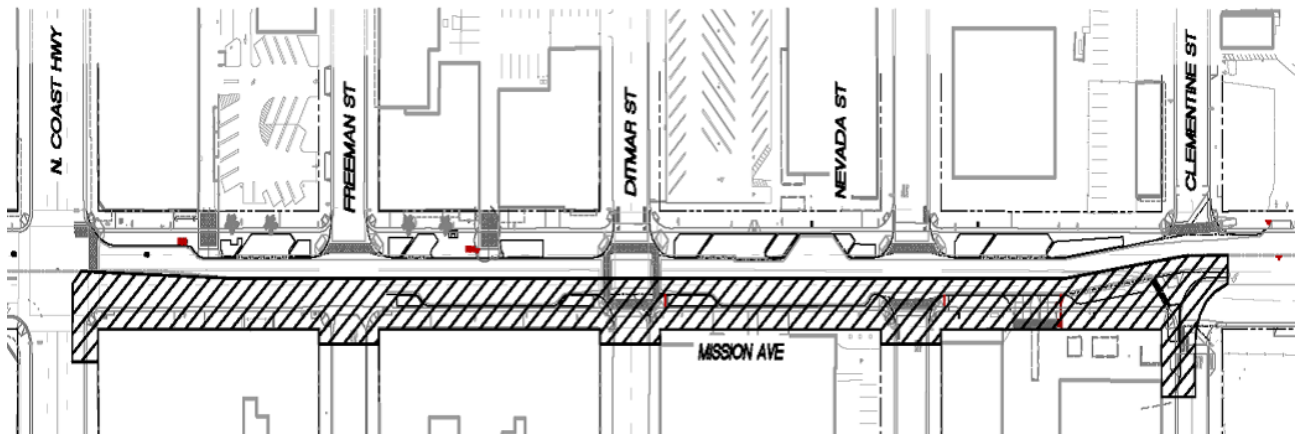
The Planning Commission meeting for May 19, 2014 was cancelled.

Development Services

Mission Avenue Improvement Project

Construction: Construction Stage 3 and Construction Stage 4 (from Clementine to Coast Highway) are both currently under construction (as shown below). This week (May 19-23), asphalt was placed from Clementine to Ditmar. Storm drain installation continued from Ditmar to Coast Highway. Curb and gutter and colored crosswalks were placed on the northwest corner of Coast Highway and Mission Avenue. Next week (May 26-30), intersection work on the northwest corner of Coast Highway and Mission will continue. The remaining sidewalk (pedestrian access) from Clementine to Ditmar will be removed and replaced. While this happens, temporary wooden bridges will be placed at business fronts for pedestrian access from Nevada to Ditmar. Storm drain installation will continue between Ditmar and Coast Highway. Landscaping will begin on the north side of Mission Avenue. Pedestrian access to businesses will remain open at all times.

Business Relations: Main Street Oceanside, Arcadis and City staff continue to communicate with businesses.
