Development Services

Mission Avenue Improvement Project

Construction: Construction Stage 4 (from Ditmar to Coast Highway on the south side of Mission) is currently under construction. This week (June 30- July 3), sidewalk and asphalt pavement was placed on Phase 4 from Ditmar to Coast Highway. Next week (July 7-11), landscaping is scheduled to be completed on the south side of Mission Avenue from Clementine to Ditmar. Remaining sidewalk work (adjacent to the businesses) on the south side of Mission from Ditmar to Coast Highway will begin. Work on Coast Highway will resume. Pedestrian access to businesses will remain open at all times.

4th of July on Coast Highway: Construction activities and temporary traffic control related to the work on Coast Highway will be removed to accommodate the 4th of July holiday weekend. Work on Coast Highway will resume on July 7.

Business Relations: Staff will continue to work with Main Street Oceanside, Special Events, OPD and businesses to coordinate construction activities during the July 4th weekend. Staff gave a project update at Main Street Oceanside on July 1.

Property Management

El Corazon – Reclamation Plan Grading Project & Multi-Use Athletic Fields

Development- Earlier this year, the City Council approved a change order to the grading contract with Bonsall Petroleum Construction, Inc. ("BPC"). The change order accelerated the grading of the fields portion of the pad at El Corazon, so as to be completed by July 1, 2014. As of the close of business July 3, 2014, the grading of the fields portion of the pad has been completed. The grading of the reservoir area has also been completed.

A significant portion of the pad area for the fields, as well as the reservoir area, was actually turned over to SoCal S.C. LP ("SoCal") earlier in June 2014. This allowed SoCal to begin the installation of their water distribution system needed for the development of the multi-use athletic fields ("Fields"). However, as a result of some irrigation material delivery delays and technical issues in completing the development plan for the installation of the Fields on the part of SoCal (e.g., new storm water regulations), the installation of the grass sod is now scheduled for some time in August.

The August installation date still gives the grass sod sufficient time to "mature" so as to allow SoCal to schedule their first tournaments at El Corazon for some time in November 2014, including the prestigious "Surf Cup" during the Thanksgiving Holiday. What remains to be

completed by BPC are the parking lot area and the storm water improvements. BPC is scheduled to complete these items in ample time for the first scheduled tournaments by SoCal.

Additionally, due to issues typically encountered when mass grading a site, interruptions in the anticipated delivery of suitable fill material, and changes in the storm water regulation that occurred after the project started, additional costs were incurred. Although some of the costs were unforeseen, there are sufficient funds available in the El Corazon accounts to cover the additional costs. As the project draws nearer to completion, staff will reconcile the additional costs associated with the project for City Council's approval.
